

COVID-19 vaccination clinics continue at the locations and times below. Bring a photo ID. Those due for their second dose are reminded to bring their COVID-19 immunization card.

Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and provide government -issued identification to validate age. Minor's birth certificate is acceptable. Parent/legal guardian must have a government-issued ID. Guardians must also present legal guardianship or power-of-attorney document.

Much like the vaccination success we have experienced in Guam, Korea is impressively approaching its vaccination goal of reaching herd immunity by November. With over 70% of Korea's total population having received its first dose and over 43% being fully immunized this month, we have every reason to be optimistic about an upswing in arrivals in the month's ahead.

A great many thanks to our airline partners for their continued support and commitment to Guam. This October we look forward to welcoming back Seoul and Jeju Air with weekly and twice weekly service to Guam. Air Busan also plans to resume service to Guam via Busan twice weekly, opening another gateway from Korea. TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS BY MARKET





JAPAN

- Only Japanese nationals and foreign nationals with valid status of residence are allowed to enter Japan
- Japanese government does not distinguish between vaccinated and unvaccinated travelers for entry requirements
- All arrivals, regardless of nationality are subject to 14-day quarantine
- Secure negative certificate 72 hours prior to departure; airline to verify; test again upon arrival
- Download 3 apps on smartphone* (MySOS, Google Maps and COCOA)
 * Traveler will be required to rent a smartphone if they do not own one
- For Japanese nationals who have negative result in both tests, requested to 14-days home self-quarantine

FOR JAPANESE NATIONALS 14-DAY HOME QUARANTINE

Note:
14 days begins from the day
after you enter Japan

SOUTH KOREA

- All travelers to South Korea must provide proof of a negative PCR test result collected within 72 hours of their departure.
- As of May 5, those fully vaccinated in South Korea can bypass quarantine; As of Aug 30, PCR test required on Day 1 and Day 6/7 of arrival
- Those not fully vaccinated in Korea must undergo 14-day home quarantine; PCR tests required on day 1 and day 12/13 of arrival.
- Korean nationals arriving without a negative PCR test will be required to undergo a 7-day quarantine at a government facility at their expense (\$120/day), followed by 7 days of home quarantine.
- Foreigners arriving without a negative PCR test will be denied entry.
- Children five years old or below are exempted from the negative PCR test result requirement and quarantine if parent or guardian are fully vaccinated and have submitted a valid negative PCR test result.
- Korean resident who receives their first dose in Korea and receives their second dose on Guam, may bypass quarantine upon re-entry in Korea if they register and their 2nd dose to the Korean public health center. Korean resident should call +82-1339 (Korean Public Health)

TAIWAN

- Requires a negative PCR test 72 hours prior to departure
- Fill out electronic health declaration form prior to departure via Quarantine System for Entry @ https://hdhq.mohw.gov.tw
- Travelers are required to make an affidavit stating that the location of their intended **14-day quarantine** in Taiwan meets relevant regulations
- All travelers will be quarantined for 14 days with the following exceptions: Taiwan tourists who participate in the Palau Travel Corridor program only need 5 days enforcement self-hearth monitoring + 9 days self-health monitoring (individual is not allow to take any public transportations in this period)

FOR ARRIVING TRAVELERS

14-DAY QUARANTINE IN GOVERNMENT FACILITY

Does not include those who participate in Palau Travel Corridor program

PHILIPPINES

- All nationals/Filipinos, including spouse and children (Filipino/foreign), foreign crew members, foreign government and international organization officials accredited to the Philippines and foreign nationals allowed under relevant IATF resolutions are permitted entry to the Philippines
- Undertake COVID-19 testing at the quarantine hotel/facility on day 6 from arrival
- Be within the max capacity of inbound passengers
- Have a pre-booked accommodation for at least seven nights in an accredited quarantine hotel/facility

Fully vaccinated, arriving from green country (min 14-days) and test negative on day 6
7-DAY QUARANTINE IN GOVERNMENT FACILITY

All other arriving travelers

10-DAY QUARANTINE IN GOVERNMENT

JAPAN

- Government lifted the COVID-19 state of emergency
- 56% of the eligible population is fully vaccinated
- Total cases from Sept 20-26 has decreased by 51% from the previous week
- Government aims to complete the vaccination of up to 60% of the population by end of September
- Japanese vaccination certificate has been approved by total 37 countries and regions; will be issued as early as this year
- Effective October 1, the self-isolation period for fully vaccinated arriving travelers will be reduced from 14 to 10 days (only applicable to those vaccinated with Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca)
- Government decided to administer booster shots beginning with healthcare workers and senior citizens
- · Most travel agencies cancelled organized tours until the end of October
- Daily flights (NRT-GUM) UA196/197; all other UA flights suspended until mid-December; JAL flight (NRT-GUM) suspended until November 30; T'way and Jeju Air flights (KIX-GUM) suspended until October 30
- Marketing activities: social media and Instalive x Tabimuse campaign

PHILIPPINES

- Department of Health said COVID-19 vaccinations among minors aged 12 to 17 will begin with children who have underlying medical conditions
- Patients who have beaten the disease have reached 2,365,229 as 12,236 new recoveries were recorded
- U.S. will deliver an additional 2,582,190 doses of the Pfizer vaccine to the PI
- Pl's risk classification for Covid-19 is down to moderate as the two-week growth rate of infections nationwide has gone negative
- · PAL flying two times per week and UA flying daily n October

SOUTH KOREA

- 308,725 cases to date (33,527/10% active)
- 52.6% of the 18 and older population is fully vaccinated
- Daily cases reached a record high in the 3,000s after Chuseok holiday
- South Korea extends pandemic-driven advisory against overseas travel until October 13
- To boost the fully-vaccinated rate, South Korea has decided to allow people to book their second shot with leftover COVID-19 vaccines from September 17
- Asiana Airlines will re-launch the ICN-GUM regular route for the first time in 18 years; regular flights expected to return end of December

- Anticipated airline seat capacity for Oct and Nov shown in appendix
- October capacity: 5,454 seats
- November capacity: 9,858 seats







HIGHLIGHTS

JAPAN POPULATION: 127 MILLION

- In Japan, 156,559,895 doses have been administered to date.
- 70% of the total population of 127.1 million have received the first dose and 56% have been fully vaccinated.
- Senior citizens aged 65 years and over were vaccinated at 90% for the first dose and 89% for the second dose.
- The government targets to complete the vaccination of up to 60% of the population by the end of September.





TOKYO 13 MILLION POPULATION




AICHI 7.5 MILLION POPULATION






FUKUOKA 5.1 MILLION POPULATION

HIGHLIGHT

Japanese vaccination certificate has been approved by total 37 other countries and regions.

DIGITAL VACCINE CERTIFICATE

- Total 37 other countries and regions approved.
- Digital vaccination certificates to be issued as early as this year.
- Introduction of a dedicated application.
- Retrieve the vaccination information from the QR Code.
- Enter a 4-digit PIN using your personal number card.
- QR code contains information such as name, vaccination history, and the vaccine brand.

RELAXATION OF ENTRY RESTRICTIONS


GOVERNMENT PLAN:

- Shorten the period of self-isolation upon arrival for vaccinated people from 14 to 10 days.
- Apply to people who have received two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine approved in Japan (Pfizer, Moderna and AstraZeneca).
- Come to effect in October.

THE JAPAN BUSINESS FEDERATION'S REQUEST:

- Waive 14days-quarantine completely for fully vaccinated arrivals.
- Reduce self-quarantine period from 14days to 10day regardless of being vaccinated.







REVISION OF QUARANTINE POLICY

ENTRY TO JAPAN

HIGHLIGHTS

- Allow arrivals from 6 countries blacklisted over the spread of the highly contagious delta variant of the coronavirus.
- 6 countries : Afghanistan, Bangladesh, India, Maldives, Nepal and Sri Lanka
- No longer valid for staying at government facilities for 6 or 10 days.
- Mandatory 3 days measure will be required only for 45 counties below.

Other countries:

• Rest of countries and region including Japanese citizen and residence in Guam requires 14-day self-quarantine. (at present)

New measure for 45 countries.

- Three days of waiting at the mandatory quarantine station.
- PCR test on the third day.
- Leave the station if negative.

45 countries:


Afghanistan, Argentina, Bangladesh, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Britain, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Denmark, Dominica, Ecuador, Georgia, Greece, India, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Libya, Malaysia, the Maldives, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Paraguay, Peru, the Philippines, Portugal, Russia (but only arrivals from Khabarovsk and Moscow), Seychelles, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Suriname, Tanzania, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, U.A.E., Uruguay, Uzbekistan, Venezuela and Zambia.

QUARANTINE MEASURES:

Self-quarantine period upon arrival will reduce 14 to 10 days, which come to effective 10/1. (Apply for both Japanese and Guam people)

BOOSTER VACCINE SHOT

- Government decided to give booster shots in Japan
- Healthcare workers by year-end
- Seniors citizen (+65) in early new year
- Already secured enough doses to enable them to receive booster shots







UNCLEAR ISSUES:

Vaccine type for the third shots.

The merits of mixing vaccines to maximize immunity. Who will be prioritized after medical personnel and older people have received their third.

OTHER COUNTRIES:

- Britain, Germany and France: started in September.
- US: CDC to approve shots for people aged 65 and over, medical workers, etc.





- South Korea extended its special advisory against overseas travel for another month amid the continued spread of the new coronavirus.
- The measure, which calls for citizens to cancel or postpone trips abroad, will remain in effect until Oct. 13.

GETTING SECOND VACCINE DOSES BECOMES EASIER IN KOREA



- To boost the fully-vaccinated rate, Korea has decided to allow people to book their second shots with leftover Covid-19 vaccines from Sept. 17.
- Before the modification of this policy, leftover vaccines had not been available to those who already had their first shot, as the second shot was automatically booked at the same medical facility as the first shot.

S. KOREA'S DAILY VIRUS CASES TOP 3,000 FOR FIRST TIME AFTER CHUSEOK HOLIDAY



- South Korea's daily coronavirus cases exceeded 3,000 for the first time as people returned home from the Chuseok holiday on Sept. 25.
- The country reported an all-time high number of daily cases for the second consecutive day, of which the Seoul metropolitan area accounted for 77 percent of the total infections.



S. KOREA MODIFIES ITS VACCINATION SYSTEM AND SCHEDULE

- To boost the fully-vaccinated rate, Korea is allowing people to book their second shots with leftover Covid-19 vaccines starting on Sept. 17.
- With the leftover vaccines, people who received the Pfizer vaccine can now book a second shot three weeks after their first, four weeks for Moderna and four to 12 weeks for AstraZeneca.

ASIANA AIRLINES TO OPEN ICN-GUM REGULAR ROUTE, PREPARING FOR "WITH COVID-19"

- Asiana Airlines will re-launch the ICN-GUM regular route for the first time in 18 years, which was withdrawn in 2003 due to decrease in profitability.
- Asiana Airlines recently received approval from the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport for the ICN-GUM regular route and is expected to open its regular flights late December.

VIETNAM PLANS TO OPEN PHU QUOC FOR VACCINATED FOREIGN TOURISTS

- Vietnam plans to reopen Phu Quoc to foreign tourists from October as the country looks at ways to revive its economy.
- Vietnam would fully vaccinate all residents on Phu Quoc before opening, adding the island had sufficient COVID-19 quarantine and treatment facilities.



ANOTHER BATCH OF JAPAN-DONATED COVID-19 VACCINES ARRIVES IN TAIWAN

- A total of 500,000 doses of the AstraZeneca (AZ) COVID-19 vaccine from Japan arrived in Taiwan on Saturday, the fifth such donation made by Tokyo to Taipei so far.
- The Japan Airlines JL809 flight carrying the vaccines from Tokyo touched down at Taoyuan International Airport at 1:16 p.m.



 According to Taiwan's Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC), a portion of the donated vaccines will expire on Nov. 26 and the rest will expire on Nov. 30.

TAIWAN TO RELAX LEVEL 2 RESTRICTIONS AFTER 1ST-DOSE VACCINATION RATE REACHES 60%

- The head of Taiwan's CECC said the country will relax its Level 2 epidemic control restrictions once the first-dose vaccination rate reaches 60%.
- Premier Su Tseng-chang on Wednesday (Sept. 22) told the Legislative Yuan the percentage of people who have received at least one dose of the vaccine will reach 60% at the beginning of October and 70% by the end of that month. Su said that by October's end, the second-dose vaccination rate should be close to 30%.



- Health Minister and CECC head Chen Shih-chung said that once 60% of the
 population has had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, the center would
 begin to lower epidemic control measures. However, he emphasized the
 center would still need to look at implementing a "new epidemic prevention
 lifestyle" and that three factors will need to be considered before loosening
 restrictions.
- Also Friday, Taoyuan Mayor Cheng Wen-tsan said that if the first-dose vaccination rate reaches 70% by the end of October, he will ask the CECC to lower the epidemic alert from Level 2 to Level 1. Chen said that once the coverage rate reaches 60%, some of the industries that have been shuttered can resume operations.

SLOVAKIA-DONATED COVID-19 VACCINES ARRIVE IN TAIWAN

- The 160,000 doses of the AstraZeneca (AZ) COVID-19 vaccine from Slovakia arrived in Taiwan on Sunday, and will be used in a planned rollout as second vaccination doses for people who have already received a first shot.
- In mid-July, the European Union announced that Slovakia had pledged to donate a total of 10,000 doses of vaccines to Taiwan.
- However, on Friday, Slovakia's Ministry of revealed Economy that the nation was provide able to 150,000 another doses. thanks to concerted efforts within the Slovakian government.

- On September 23, the CECC pointed out that the list of key high-risk countries, after adjustment, includes India, the UK, Israel, Indonesia, and Myanmar. Travelers with history of travel to the five countries shall stay in group quarantine facilities for the 14-day quarantine and cooperate with the required testing measure during the quarantine period.
- The latest list of the risk categories for countries/regions is as follows:
 - Level 1 (Watch): None
 - Level 2 (Alert): Palau
 - Level 3 (Warning): the rest of the countries/regions in the world except for Palau
- CECC restarts entry program for overseas students on a case-bycase basis as pandemic continues to subside in Taiwan.





TAIWAN'S FIRST-DOSE COVID-19 VACCINATION RATE EXCEEDS 50%

Over 50 percent of people in Taiwan have received the first of dose COVID-19 vaccine. six months after the rollout began on March 22, the CECC said Thursday.



- As of 10 a.m. on Thursday, just over 11.76 million people in Taiwan had gotten their first vaccine shot, which is 50.16 percent of Taiwan's population of 23.45 million, according to data from the CECC and the Department of Household Registration.
- But only around 1.82 million people, or 7.7 percent of the population, have received the two doses needed to be fully vaccinated.
- Taiwan began its COVID-19 vaccine rollout on March 22, though take-up was low in the beginning. At the time, Taiwan had reported fewer than 1,100 COVID-19 cases, most of which were imported, and there had been no widespread community transmission of the disease.

TAIWAN EASES QUARANTINE RULES FOR VISITORS FROM PERU, BANGLADESH AND BRAZIL

 Visitors arriving in Taiwan from Peru, Bangladesh, and Brazil will no longer be required to quarantine at a government center from Sept. 25, and can instead choose to quarantine at hotels, CECC said Thursday.



- The change is because the three countries will no longer be listed as "key high-risk countries," as their COVID-19 case numbers have continued to fall, the CECC said.
- Also, no travelers from the three nations to Taiwan have been confirmed to be infected with variants of the coronavirus in the past two months, the CECC said.
- The revised classification will allow travelers from the three countries more choice in where they carry out the mandatory 14-day quarantine, though they will now be required to pay for their accommodation.
- Currently, Taiwan requires travelers who have been to or transited through "key high-risk countries" in the last 14 days before entering Taiwan to quarantine at a government-designated facility. They can stay at the facility for free.
- Countries included on the "key high-risk countries" list are India, the United Kingdom, Israel, Indonesia and Myanmar.

- Starting 00:00 on July 18 (time of arrival in Taiwan), arriving travelers from Brazil, India, the UK, Peru, Israel, Indonesia, Bangladesh and Myanmar (including
 those who have visited or transited in those countries in the past 14 days) will be required to quarantine in group quarantine facilities for 14 days and
 undergo PCR tests for COVID-19 upon checking in at group quarantine facilities and at the end of their quarantine period.
- 3. Beginning 00:00 am, May 19 (departure time at the airport of departure), non- R.O.C. nationals without a valid ARC will be temporarily barred from entry. Transit via Taiwan will be temporarily suspended.
- 4. Personnel on diplomatic/official business, migrant workers, students, should follow instructions by Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Labor, and Ministry of Education.

VACCINATIONS FOR MINORS AGED 12-17 TO START WITH THOSE WITH COMORBIDITIES

The Department of Health (DOH) recently said that COVID-19 vaccinations among minors aged 12 to 17 will begin with children who have underlying medical conditions.

Minors belonging to this group will be considered as part of the government's A3 category or persons with comorbidities, while others will become eligible to get vaccinated "once adequate coverage of the A2 priority group or senior citizens has been achieved nationwide and vaccine supply becomes sufficient to include children."

Malacañang's regular Laging Handa briefing, DOH Undersecretary Myrna Cabotaje said that the rollout of vaccines to minors with comorbidities may start as early as October 15 and could begin with a pilot run in Metro Manila.



PH RECOVERIES HIT 2,365,229

The country's overall tally of coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) patients who have beaten the disease have reached 2.365,229 as 12,236 new recoveries were recorded as of Wednesday.

The Department of Health (DOH) said the figure is equivalent to a 93.3-percent recovery rate from a total of 2,535,732 infections since the start of the pandemic last year.

U.S. PROVIDES 2.58 MILLION MORE PFIZER-BIONTECH VACCINES TO THE PHILIPPINES

The United States partnered with the COVID-19 Vaccines Global Access (COVAX) facility to deliver an additional 2,582,190 doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to the Philippines as part of its worldwide effort to help end COVID-19.

The vaccines, delivered in separate shipments on September 19 and 20, were part of the 500 million doses of Pfizer the United States is making available for distribution through COVAX, a global initiative to support equitable access to COVID-19 vaccines.

Newly arrived U.S. Embassy in the Philippines Chargé d'Affaires Heather Variava j oined Philippine government officials and other stakeholders at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport to welcome the arrival of 2,020,590 doses on September 19 and 561,600 doses on September 20.

As the largest donor to the COVAX facility, the United States has facilitated the delivery of more than 16 million vaccine doses to the Philippines via COVAX, including more than 9 million doses donated by the American people.



PH COVID-19 RISK CLASSIFICATION DOWNGRADED TO MODERATE

The country's risk classification for Covid-19 is down to moderate on Monday as the two-week growth rate of infections nationwide has gone negative. The average daily reported cases nationwide for the week Sept. 20 to 26 decreased to 17,783 from 19,949 the previous week.



"We're at negative 4 percent in the recent one to two weeks, much lower than the 27 percent we reported the week prior," Department of Health Epidemiology Bureau Director Dr. Alethea de Guzman said during a televised Palace briefing.

Bed utilization for Covid-19 patients remained at moderate risk at under 68 percent while intensive care unit utilization (ICU) rate is high risk at under 76 percent. Three regions logged negative two-week growth rates – National Capital Region (NCR) -13 percent; Calabarzon, -18 percent; and Region 3 (Central Luzon), - 13 percent. NCR's bed utilization rate is lower at 63 percent as against the 68 percent reported a few days ago. ICU utilization rate remains a high-risk 76 percent, slightly lower than the 78 percent a few weeks ago.
