The World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) created the first ever global safety and hygiene stamp. This stamp enables travelers to recognize destinations around the world that have adopted standardized health and hygiene protocols. The approved businesses are also featured on GVB's consumer site, <u>visitguam.com</u> in English, Japanese, Korean, and Chinese. The Safe Travels Stamp certificate is valid through December 31, 2022.

GUTIERREZ: PAUL SHIMIZU LEAVES LASTING LEGACY



Håfa Adai! On the occasion of his recent passing, I here reflect on an extraordinary man of commerce and community involvement who changed Guam's outlook on what it means to work hard/play hard and how the two goals of fruitful labor and good times can and should be rolled into one for a better quality of life.

Guam Visitors Bureau Vice Chairman Paul San Nicolas Shimizu was one of the most down-to-earth gentlemen I've ever known. That may sound like a bit of a contradiction, but as a businessman and community leader, "Uncle Paul" was only formal when he had to be.

This duality came as naturally and unassumingly as the man himself. He seemed equally at ease with the wealthiest and most powerful among us as with the common everyday folks that he catered to as a wholesaler of beverages, tobacco, household sundries, snacks and sanitary products, as a promoter of sports and musical entertainment, as a philanthropist and as a rewarding employer of hardworking Guamanians. In a word, Paul was magnanimous. Rich or poor, professional or working class, he treated everyone generously and equally, with a healthy sense of mutual respect.

In addition to GVB President & CEO, former Governor Carl T.C. Gutierrez is the permit czar and chairman of the Governor's Economic Strategy Council.

JAPAN

JAPANESE NATIONALS

NO QUARANTINE

 Traveler entering/returning to Japan from Guam (a non designated country/region) AND has received three vaccination doses AND is negative at airport is exempted from quarantine.

REQUIREMENTS

- Negative result of COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to departure (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, TRC, Smart Amp, NEAR, Next Generation Sequence, CLEIA/ECLIA)

- Submit a written pledge that you will follow the Japanese authorities requirements and fill out questionnaires
- Install mobile application (MySOS, Google Maps, COCOA; travel insurance for COVID-19 related issues recommended

QUARANTINE

Traveler entering/returning to Japan from Guam (a non designated country/region) AND has not received three vaccination doses is subject to a a 7-day home quarantine (if the voluntary test on day 3 is negative, an exemption is made from further isolation).

FOREIGN NATIONALS NEW ENTRY INTO JAPAN

(A) Foreign nationals eligible to this measure

- (1) Foreign nationals newly entering Japan for a short-term stay (less than three months) for purposes including business or employment and foreign nationals newly entering Japan for a long term stay (Except for tourist purposes)..
- (2) Foreign nationals fall under (1) and those who have receiving organizations located in Japan

SOUTH KOREA

NO QUARANTINE

- Fully vaccinated in Korea (14-180 days) or boosted can re-enter Korea without quarantine (as of March 21, 2022).
- Foreigners fully vaccinated other than Korea (14-180 days) or boosted can enter Korea without quarantine (as of April 1, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers entering Korea (nationals and foreigners) must have a negative PCR test 48-hours prior to departure to Korea and K-ETA (only foreigners).
- Upon arrival must take a PCR test within 24 hours and antigen test on day 6 or 7 (covered by the Korean government).
- Foreigners must register their travel information, vaccination records, and PCR test to KDCA's website Q-Code before entering Korea. https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/
- Fully vaccinated in Korea that had tested positive but recovered must present positive result and official documentation of recovery before boarding their flight. If recovered within 10-40 days, no PCR test is required to return to Korea. If recovered past 40 days a negative PCR test result within 48-hours before departure is required.

QUARANTINE

Unvaccinated nationals (including unvaccinated children 6-11 years old) will be required to self-quarantine for seven (7) days.

NO QUARANTINE

FULLY VACCINATED IN KOREA

- Children 5 years old and below are exempted
- Must present negative PCR result taken 48-hours before departure
- Must register COOV app

FULLY VACCINATED IN KOREA RECENTLY RECOVERED FROM COVID

- Must show positive result, official documentation of recovery
- Recovered between 10-40 days no PCR test is requested before boarding
- Recovered after 40 days, PCR result taken 48-hours before boarding is required

FULLY VACCINATED IN ANOTHER COUNTRY

- Must present negative PCR result taken 48-hours before departure
- Must register KCDA's Q-Code and complete K-ETA - Only Foreigners



TAIWAN

QUARANTINE

- All travelers will be quarantined for 10 days at a self paid facility or home isolation
- Practice self-health management for 7 days and take a rapid antigen self test on the 2nd and 4th day

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers who arrive at an airport in Taiwan must present a certificate of a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test taken within two days (calendar days) prior to the flight schedule time to the airline staff
- Fill out electronic health declaration form prior to departure via Quarantine System for Entry @ https://hdhq.mohw.gov.tw
- Those who enter Taiwan shall arrange quarantine accommodation (a quarantine hotel or group quarantine facility where they plan to stay at their own expense) before visiting the country. Such travelers must also state that they have met related requirements by making relevant affidavits on the Quarantine System for Entry.



PHILIPPINES

NO QUARANTINE

- Fully vaccinated nationals / foreign nationals
- Children below 12 years who cannot be vaccinated shall follow quarantine protocols of the parent or accompanying adult/guardian

REQUIREMENTS

- Negative RT-PCR test result taken within 48 hours prior to departure from Guam
- OR a negative laboratory-based antigen test result taken within 24 hours prior to departure from Guam
- All inbound passengers shall register with the One Health Pass prior to arrival in the Philippines
- Self-monitor for any sign or symptom until the 7th day from arrival

FACILITY-BASED QUARANTINE

Unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, unverified nationals are subject to a facility-based quarantine until release of negative results (5th day swabbing); self-monitor until 14th day of arrival.

Travelers are considered Fully Vaccinated if:

- They received 2nd dose series or single dose vaccine for more than 14 days prior to departure from country of origin
- Vaccine is included in EUA list or compassionate special permit (CSP) issued by the Philippine Food and Drug Administration OR EU listing of WHO

Accepted proofs of vaccination:

- World Health Organization (WHO) International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis; OR
- VaxCertPH; OR
- National/state certificate of the foreign government, including original CDC vaccination cards for those vaccinated in the US





JAPAN COVID-19 NEWS



HIGHLIGHTS

- The number of new cases nationwide increased 11% from last week to approximately 339,000.
- The number of infections per 100,000 population was approximately 263 in Japan and 377 in Tokyo. (4/2-4/8)
- The number of infected cases has turned around from a declining trend to an increasing trend. However, Prime Minister Kishida has hinted at a switch to prioritize economic activities by placing Covid-19 on par with seasonal influenza.




The number of infected people per 100,000 population:





ENTRY PROTOCOLS

HIGHLIGHTS

- The level of MOFA's "Overseas Travel Safety Information" has been lowered to "Level 2".
- Effective March 1, those returning from the U.S. (including Guam) who have completed their third vaccination are exempt from quarantine if they are negative upon return, while those who have completed their second or lower vaccinations are quarantined at home for three days.
- Effective April 10, the daily entry limit for new foreigners other than for tourism purposes will be relaxed to 10,000.

- We will launch #HereGuam and decide on a theme for each month and post materials that were taken the other day to create a sense of unity.



KDCA'S NEW QUARANTINE MEASURES FROM APRIL 11



- As South Korea's omicron wave is on a clear downward trend, the government decided to make a shift in the current quarantine measure.
- It aims to gradually reduce the number of hospital beds secured for COVID-19 patients and scale back residential treatment centers and screening stations.

COVID-19 TESTING

Rapid antigen testing will no longer be available at COVID-19 screening centers at public health centers from April 11

Those under the age of 60 can get tested only at local hospitals and clinics

ARRIVAL PROTOCOL FOR FOREIGN RESIDENTS

Long-term foreign residents with a confirmed record of COVID-19 in Korea, 10 to 40 days before the departure date, would no longer have to submit a negative PCR test result upon arrival effective from April 11

However, those who are confirmed positive in overseas are not exempted from PCR test result submission

KOREA BEGINS TRANSITION TO 'POST-OMICRON' ERA

The government will soon announce a post-omicron scheme, along with a decision on downgrading the infectious disease level of COVID-19. The compulsory quarantine period for all COVID-19 patients will be shortened or possibly gotten rid of altogether as well, once the infectious disease level of COVID-19 is set lower. Meanwhile, it will reveal adjusted social distancing rules this Friday, aiming at normalizing the medical system to pre-pandemic days.





BOOSTER SHOTS FOR PREVIOUS COVID-19 CONFIRMED PATIENTS BEING CONSIDERED

The government is considering whether to recommend a third dose of vaccine to people with history of confirmed COVID-19 as the 4th vaccination was allowed for the elderly in the US and Europe. Currently, if a person has completed the second dose of the vaccine and has a history of confirmed COVID-19, the third dose is not recommended.

KOREA'S INTL. FLIGHTS TO QUARANTINE-FREE NATIONS TO INCREASE SHARPLY STARTING IN MAY

The government will increase the weekly number of international flights to the US. Europe and other COVID-19 quarantinefree nations by 100 flights every month starting in May in line with growing demand for overseas travel. It is expected that the rate of expansion will be further increased to 300 flights everv month from July along with the normalization of international flight services at regional airports such as Muan, Cheongju and Jeju intl. airport.



TRAVEL PARTNER'S EFFORTS FOR TRAVEL RESUMPTION TO GUAM

As the omicron wave is slowing after reaching its peak in mid-March, even the new COVID-19 cases falling below 100,000 for the first time in almost two months as of April 11, travel trade partners are opening up diverse promotions for Guam travel in line with the increasing travel demand.



- Partnered with PHR's five local hotels to provide various benefits for passengers on the PUS-GUM route from May 6 to 31.
- Five affiliated hotels: The Tsubaki Tower, PIC Guam, Hilton Guam Resort & Spa, Hotel Nikko Guam, and Righa Royal Laguna Guam Resort.

AIR SEOUL

- Will provide customers with special-price tickets on a first-come, first-served basis along with the hotel-affiliated event promotions.
- Air Seoul passengers can also get additional discounts on local rent-a-cars and optional activities through 'Guamjoa.com', an option tour company.



- Will open a total of 40 domestic and overseas package products and promotions at special price from April 5, under the concept of "Monthly Overseas Travel".
- Will sell popular travel packages to 400 people on a first-come, firstserved basis for a month in April, which includes Guam, Saipan, Southeast Asian countries, etc.



TRAVEL TRADE PARTNERS REQUESTING FOR OVERALL ABOLITION OF PCR TEST

Aviation and travel industries are demanding government to abolish predeparture and on-arrival PCR tests, which are mandatory conditions for entry in Korea. They are arguing that mandatory PCR tests in Korea are working as a major obstacle to the recovery of the travel industry as it can be a huge burden for travelers both in financial and psychological aspect.





TAIWAN SUSPENDS SOME COVID CONTACT TRACING, ADOPTS NEW CONTROL MODEL



Health and Welfare Minister Chen Shih-chung said Thursday that COVID-19 contact tracing has been partially suspended in Taiwan and a new disease control model is being put in place, amid a rise in domestic cases.

The immediate suspension of contract tracing applies only to travelers who test positive for COVID-19 in Taiwan, either on arrival at the airport or during mandatory quarantine, Chen said. That decision was made in a bid to free up resources to monitor the growing number of domestic COVID-19 cases, he said at a press briefing, after he reported 531 new cases -- 382 domestically transmitted and 149 imported.

Chen said contact tracing on new imported cases will only be done if any of them are believed to be linked to COVID-19 clusters at quarantine hotels or quarantine centers in Taiwan.

Regarding the recent daily rise in domestic infections, Chen said the current goal is to bring the situation under control, even though it is impossible to achieve zero new domestic cases at this time.

CECC MULLS HOME QUARANTINE FOR PEOPLE WITH LIGHT COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

CECC is evaluating plans to have people with light COVID-19 symptoms quarantine at home if the number of domestic cases in Taiwan continues to rise, Health Minister Chen Shih-chung said Wednesday.

Chen made the comments during the CECC's daily press briefing, after reporting 281 new domestically-transmitted COVID-19 cases, marking the highest daily total this year and the sixth consecutive day in which local cases have exceeded 100.

Despite the rising case totals, only five of the 2,061 domestic cases recorded between Jan. 1 and April 5, or 0.24 percent, had moderate to severe symptoms of the disease, while the others were either mild or asymptomatic, CECC data showed.

Home quarantine for light COVID-19 cases:

When asked about an appeal by New Taipei Mayor Hou Yu-ih, whose city has been a hotspot during the recent outbreak, to begin allowing COVID-19 patients with light symptoms quarantine at home, Chen confirmed that planning is already underway.



QUARANTINE RULES RELAXED AMID GROWING COVID CASES FROM UNKNOWN SOURCES

Home quarantine rules for people in Taiwan confirmed as having come into contact with COVID-19 positive individuals have been relaxed amid growing local infections from unknown sources, the CECC said Wednesday. (April 6)

Before the relaxed rules were announced, people listed as contacts of confirmed cases and ordered by the health authorities to isolate at home had to do so in an independent living unit.



Under the new rules, which came in effect Wednesday, people required to undergo home quarantine can do so in their residence, even if they do not live alone, according to the CECC.

The new rules have introduced. been Minister said Health and Welfare Chen Shih-chung during a CECC press briefing that day, because the current spread of COVID-19 in Taiwan mainly involves the more infectious Omicron variant of the virus.

TAIWAN EASES ISOLATION RULES FOR MILD, ASYMPTOMATIC COVID-19 CASES

People in Taiwan who positive test for COVID-19 but have no symptoms or only a mild infection can now reduce their period of isolation, once their tests show they are not highly contagious, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) said Sunday. (April 3)

For new COVID-19 cases, isolation can end whenever the patient obtains two consecutive negative PCR tests or a cycle threshold (CT) test with a value of 30 or higher, the CECC said, explaining that the higher the CT value, the lower the virus load.



All travelers arriving in Taiwan, however, will still have to observe 10 days of quarantine, either in a designated hotel or at home, and must obtain a negative COVID-19 PCR test before their quarantine could end, said Lo Yichun, deputy head of the CECC's medical response division.'

Everyone who tests positive for COVID-19 must conduct seven days of self-health management after their release from isolation and take two rapid tests during that seven-day period, he said at a press briefing Sunday.




TAIWAN STILL PLANS TO OPEN UP GRADUALLY, DESPITE CASE SPIKE: PREMIER

Despite a recent spike in locally transmitted COVID-19 cases, Taiwan still intends to open up the country gradually and focus on balancing disease prevention and economic development, Premier Su Tseng-chang said Friday. (April 1)

Taiwan now has enough COVID-19 vaccines in inventory and sufficient medical resources to leave the government willing to take some risks, but it will continue to closely monitor the disease's spread and make required adjustments.

Emergency measures, such as imposing a lockdown, will only be implemented if there is an unexpected surge of cases, the premier said.







CON CALL WITH AGODA GLOBAL GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS MANAGER HSIAO

Date: Apr 7

 GTO and Agoda manager conducted a con call again to discuss the plan provided by Agoda last time. Since the promotional plan is mainly aimed at all consumers (not only Taiwanese), GTO suggested Agoda to make a proposal and will continue to follow up.





- CECC announced that it has begun devising plans for quarantine, moving towards reducing the 14-day quarantine to a 10-day quarantine followed by a 7-day self-health management. (Feb. 14)
- From April 1-30, current mask mandate and other epidemic prevention measures to remain in place, and epidemic prevention rules for certain leisure and entertainment venues to be enhanced: (Mar. 28)
- CECC revises criteria for releasing COVID-19 cases with mild or no symptoms from isolation to preserve for isolation care capacity. (Apr. 3)

On February 24, CECC announced that quarantine for all arrivals will be reduced to 10 days starting on March 7, 2022

A. REQUIRED QUARANTINE PERIOD AND QUARANTINE LOCATION:

- a. The number of days an arrival should quarantine will be shortened to 10 days, and the day of arrival counts as Day 0; a seven-day self-health management will be required starting the 11th day.
- b. The arrival should quarantine at home or a residence of his or her family or friends, and the principle of one person per residence should be observed.
 - If the principle of one person per residence cannot be followed, the arrival should complete the 10-day quarantine at a quarantine hotel.
- c. Family members/household members who arrive on the same day may choose to quarantine together in their home or a residence of their friends or family or they may stay in the same quarantine quarter depending on their willingness and room types of the quarantine hotel where they stay.

B. TESTING MEASURES:

a. PCR testing:


Arrivals will undergo a PCR test upon arrival (Day 0) as currently required.

Before the end of quarantine (the 10th day of quarantine), arrivals will undergo another PCR test at a hospital or a location arranged or designated by their local government. Those testing negative should continue to practice a sevenday self-health management after being released from quarantine.

b. At-home rapid testing:
At-home rapid tests: Starting on
March 17, a COVID-19 rapid antigen
self-test will be mandatory on the
2nd and 4th day of the seven-day
self-health management period that
follows quarantine or home isolation.

On April 3, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that it has revised the criteria for releasing COVID-19 cases with mild or no symptoms from isolation as most imported cases had been infected with COVID-19 before entry. Related revisions are listed below.

- A. For new cases or cases who have a Ct value <30 in their first PCR test, the criterion which prescribes that "10 days have passed since the date of symptom onset or the date of specimen collection" has been deleted.
- B. For cases who have a Ct value ≥30 in their first PCR test, the criterion which prescribes that "the result for SARS-CoV-2 anti-N IgG antibodies is positive" has been deleted.

The Holy Week holidays are sure to trigger a surge in revenge travel—or the rush for bookings for trips and vacations in this pandemic era-going by the crowd of passengers being anticipated one transport

The Department of Transportation has designated the period of Palm Sunday, April 10, until April 18 as "Oplan Biyaheng Ayos: Summer Vacation 2022," in line with the government's efforts to revive the travel and tourism industries.

Daily passengers at the Parañague Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) are currently at 91,000 and could swell up to 110,000 this Holy Week, according to corporate affairs head Jason Salvador.



WHO WARNS OF A SURGE IN COVID-19 CASES IF **UNSAFE GATHERINGS** CONTINUE

With the unsafe gatherings and social mixing expected in the next two months, a surge in COVID-19 cases is quite likely, says a representative from the World Health Organization (WHO).

From April to May 2022, Filipinos will observe Ramadan and Holy Week and engage in electionrelated activities.

Everyone should at least wear a mask and get booster shots of COVID-19 vaccines, as prescribed by the government, to prepare for and possibly avoid a potential surge, said Dr Rajendra Yadav, Acting WHO Representative to the Philippines.

"The continuous recalibration of the country's COVID-19 response strategies is essential to prepare for a possible surge in cases and manage COVID-19 sustainably. Therefore, WHO recommends focusing on the priority groups that remain unvaccinated and house-to-house vaccination for these groups," said Dr Yadav.
