

JAPAN

JAPANESE NATIONALS

NO QUARANTINE

 Traveler entering/returning to Japan from Guam (a non designated country/region) AND has received three vaccination doses AND is negative at airport is exempted from quarantine.

REQUIREMENTS

- Negative result of COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to departure (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, TRC, Smart Amp, NEAR, Next Generation Sequence, CLEIA/ECLIA)

- Submit a written pledge that you will follow the Japanese authorities requirements and fill out questionnaires
- Install mobile application (MySOS, Google Maps, COCOA; travel insurance for COVID-19 related issues recommended

QUARANTINE

Traveler entering/returning to Japan from Guam (a non designated country/region) AND has not received three vaccination doses is subject to a a 7-day home quarantine (if the voluntary test on day 3 is negative, an exemption is made from further isolation).

FOREIGN NATIONALS NEW ENTRY INTO JAPAN

(A) Foreign nationals eligible to this measure

- (1) Foreign nationals newly entering Japan for a short-term stay (less than three months) for purposes including business or employment and foreign nationals newly entering Japan for a long term stay (Except for tourist purposes)..
- (2) Foreign nationals fall under (1) and those who have receiving organizations located in Japan

SOUTH KOREA

NO QUARANTINE

- Korea lifted the seven-day quarantine mandate for all travelers entering from abroad, regardless
 of whether they have been vaccinated or not, from June 8, in order to reduce economic damage
 and inconvenience as the virus situation has stabilized.
- Unvaccinated nationals (including unvaccinated children 6-11 years old) are no longer required to self-quarantine for seven (7) days as of June 8.

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers entering Korea (nationals and foreigners) must have a negative PCR test 2 days prior to departure OR a negative antigen test 1 day prior to departure and K-ETA (only foreigners).
- Self Administered tests are not accepted
- All travelers must take a PCR test within 3 days of arrival in Korea, as of June 1.
- Foreigners must register their travel information, and a negative PCR/Antigen test result to KDCA's website Q-Code before entering Korea. https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/
 - ❖ Korean nationals should also register Q-Code in order to shorten the time for inspection upon entry to Korea
- Fully vaccinated in Korea that had tested positive but recovered must present positive result and
 official documentation of recovery before boarding their flight. If recovered within 10-40 days, no
 PCR/Antigen test is required to return to Korea. If recovered past 40 days, must present negative
 PCR result taken 2 days before departure a or negative antigen test taken 1 day before departure

- Children 5 years old and below are exempted from pre-departure COVID-19 tests for reentry into Korea.
- All others must present negative PCR result taken 2 days before departure or a negative antigen test taken 1 day before departure

FULLY VACCINATED IN KOREA RECENTLY RECOVERED FROM COVID

- Must show positive result, official documentation of recovery
- Recovered between 10-40 days no PCR/Antigen test is requested before boarding
- Recovered after 40 days, must present negative PCR result taken 2 days before departure a or negative antigen test taken 1 day before departure

FULLY VACCINATED IN ANOTHER COUNTRY

- Must present negative PCR result taken 2 days before departure a or negative antigen test taken 1 day before departure
- Must register KCDA's Q-Code and complete K-ETA - Only Foreigners



TAIWAN

QUARANTINE

 All travelers are required to undergo a 3-day quarantine and a 4-day self-initiated epidemic prevention following the end of quarantine.

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers who arrive at an airport in Taiwan must present a certificate of a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test taken within two days (calendar days) prior to the flight schedule time to the airline staff
- Passengers from the U.S. (included Guam), Canada, New Zealand and Australia will be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival in Taiwan using a **saliva test** rather than a nasal swab
- Fill out electronic health declaration form prior to departure via Quarantine System for Entry @ https://hdhq.mohw.gov.tw
- Those who enter Taiwan shall confirm quarantine program (book a quarantine hotel in advance; or if traveler plan to quarantine at home or a residence of their family or friends, should make sure the principle of one person per residence is met)

PHILIPPINES

NO QUARANTINE

- Fully vaccinated nationals / foreign nationals
- Children below 12 years who cannot be vaccinated shall follow quarantine protocols of the parent or accompanying adult/guardian

REQUIREMENTS

- All arriving passengers must register to <u>One Health Pass</u> <u>portal</u> within 48 hours prior to departure
- Filipino and foreign nationals aged 18 and above who have received primary series of COVID-19 vaccine, and at least one (1) COVID-19 booster shot administered at any time prior to departure do NOT need a pre-departure COVID-10 test
- If not boosted, a negative RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours or negative antigen test taken within 24 hours prior to departure from the country of origin is required
- Self-monitor for any sign or symptom until the 7th day from arrival

FACILITY-BASED QUARANTINE

Unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, unverified nationals are subject to a facility-based quarantine until release of negative results (5th day swabbing); self-monitor until 14th day of arrival.

- Negative RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours or negative Antigen test taken within 24 hours prior to departure from the country of origin. Not applicable to children below 3 years old
- Facility-based quarantine until the release of the negative results, testing will be on the 5th day
- Shall self-monitor for any sign or symptom until the 14th day from arrival

TAIWAN

- Taiwan receives first shipment of Novavax vaccine
- Taiwan to maintain mask mandate through July
- Taiwan reports 61 news cases of latest Covid Omicron subvariants
- More free Covid-19 rapid tests for kids to be handed out in July
- Effective from June 1, testing upon landing ends at international airports; all arriving passengers to be required to undergo saliva tests at airports

SOUTH KOREA

- · South Korea's daily confirmed cases which has been on a downward trend for the past 14 weeks, is gradually increasing and showing a rebound in prevalence.
- · Korea government emphasized its improvement on the current COVID-19 medical institutions
- DMOs to revitalize MICE programs in line with the gradual recovery of the travel industry



JAPAN COVID-19 NEWS



HIGHLIGHTS

- The number of new patients nationwide increased by 42% from last week to about 147,000.
- The number of patients per 100,000 population was approximately 107 nationwide and 148 in Tokyo.
- The government eased waterfront measures effective June 1, raising the daily entry limit from the current 10,000 to 20,000. For those entering from areas with low risk of novel coronavirus, there will be no inspection upon arrival, with or without vaccination certificates, and there will be no waiting period.

ENTRY PROTOCOLS

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan has lowered the level of its "Overseas Travel Safety Information" to "Level 1.
- The government has raised the daily entry limit to 20,000 people since June 1. For those returning from low-risk areas such as North America (including Guam), there is no inspection upon arrival and no waiting period, regardless of whether or not there is a vaccination certificate.
- PCR testing (negative proof) within 72 hours prior to local departure remains mandatory.
- From June 12, submission of a negative PCR test certificate upon departure from Japan will no longer be required.

TAIWAN RECEIVES FIRST SHIPMENT OF NOVAVAX VACCINE

Taiwan took delivery of its first shipment of Novavax COVID-19 vaccines through COVAX on Thursday morning.

The 504,000 Novavax doses arrived at Taoyuan International Airport on board China Airlines flight CI-74 from Amsterdam, the Netherlands at 7:03 a.m.

The vaccines doses will be transported to a cold storage warehouse, where they will be inspected ahead of an expected July 8 rollout.



The 504,000 doses, which will expire on Sept. 30, are the first part of Taiwan's order of 2.268 million Novavax vaccines from COVAX, the rest of which will be delivered by the end of the year.

Under the EUA, people aged 18 and above will receive two 0.5-mL doses given three weeks apart.

The vaccine can also be used as a first or second booster shot.

TAIWAN TO MAINTAIN MASK MANDATE THROUGH JULY



Taiwan will maintain its mask mandate through the month of July, in light of the current domestic COVID-19 situation and the rising number of imported cases of the newest Omicron subvariants, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) said Wednesday.

Under the existing mandate, people are required to wear a mask at all times when they are outside their homes, except in certain situations, according to the CECC.

The exemptions apply when people are eating, participating in water-related activities, taking individual or group photos, traveling alone or with family members in a private car, or are traversing wide outdoor spaces such as fields and forests, the CECC said.

The CECC said Wednesday that other COVID-19 protocols will remain in place throughout July, including a ban on table to table toasting at banquets.

People will still be allowed, however, to eat on trains, intercity buses, ferries, and domestic flights, and to sample food at markets, the CECC said.

TAIWAN REPORTS 61 NEW CASES OF LATEST COVID OMICRON SUBVARIANTS

Sixty-one people who recently arrived in Taiwan were found to be infected with either the Omicron BA.4 or BA.5 subvariant of the COVID-19 virus, but no domestic cases of those new subvariants have been detected so far, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) said Monday.



Genome sequencing conducted in the cases of 120 passengers, who had tested positive upon arrival between June 10 and June 18, found that eight of them were infected with the Omicron BA.4 subvariant, 53 had contracted the BA.5, and 59 had the BA.2, said Lo Yi-chun, deputy head of the CECC's medical response division.

To date, Taiwan has recorded 19 cases of BA.4 and 107 cases of BA.5, all of which were among incoming travelers, Lo said.

The BA.4 cases were travelers from the United States, Singapore, Thailand, the United Kingdom, Australia, France, Chile, Malaysia, and the United Arab Emirates, he said.

MORE FREE COVID-19 RAPID TESTS FOR KIDS TO BE HANDED OUT IN JULY

The government will provide more free COVID-19 rapid antigen tests in July for children under the age of 7 years, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) said Monday.

Starting July 1, families with children born on or after Sept. 2, 2015 will be eligible to collect the free tests at any of the approximately 5,000 designated pharmacies participating in the government's rapid test rationing program.



Five free rapid tests will be allocated for each child in the under-7 age category, the CECC said, adding that parents must show the child's health insurance (NHI) card at the pharmacy.

In the first round of free test distribution in June, some 780,000 families with children under the age of 7 years received free rapid test kits, accounting for 60 percent of the eligible age group, according to the CECC.

Families that obtained free tests in June can do so again in July, the CECC said. In addition, they can buy tests under the government's rationing program, once they present the child's NHI card, the CECC said.





Effective from June 1, testing upon landing to end at international airports; all arriving passengers to be required to undergo saliva tests at airports

On May 31, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that, effective from 00:00 on June 1, 2022 (the incoming flight's arrival time in Taiwan), all passengers arriving in Taiwan from abroad will be required to have their saliva samples collected at the airport for PCR testing; after undergoing a saliva test, arrivals will proceed to follow quarantine measures.

The CECC reminded arrivals that they should not drink or eat in the period between landing and sample collection to ensure the quality of their samples; after entry, arrivals should go to their prearranged quarantine location (one person per residence protocol or quarantine hotel) to undergo quarantine. If the result from the saliva-based PCR test comes back positive, an individual observing the one person per residence protocol should receive care in their quarantine location, whereas an individual quarantining in a quarantine hotel should be sent to an enhanced quarantine hotel or government quarantine facility or a hospital as required by rules.

On June 11, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that it will loosen the border restrictions listed below, effective from 00:00 on June 15, 2022 (incoming flight's scheduled arrival time in Taiwan), provided that control of the number of arrivals will be imposed.

- A. The day of arrival counts as Day 0; a three-day home quarantine and four-day self-initiated epidemic prevention following the end of quarantine will be required. The previous seven-day self-health management will be terminated.
- B. Epidemic prevention rules to follow during the self-initiated epidemic prevention period
- C. An arrival should observe the rule of one person per residence in his or her quarantine location or stay in a quarantine hotel; in principle, the arrival should undergo the three-day quarantine and four-day self-initiated epidemic prevention in the same location. Furthermore, in consideration of shared living arrangements for migrant workers, fishermen, and students and their higher risk of cluster infection, the regulatory authority of the respective business will ask such individuals to complete the self-initiated epidemic prevention period in their quarantine location and not to attend classes, work, or go out unless necessary during the period.

Testing measures:

- A. Arrivals must present a COVID-19 PCR test result within two days before their scheduled flight to Taiwan.
- B. PCR testing: deep-throat saliva samples will be collected from arrivals for PCR testing at the airport/port on the day of arrival (Day 0).
- C. At-home rapid tests: two rapid test kits will be given to arrivals aged 2 and older by workers at international airports/ports upon arrival; arrivals can use the test kits when symptoms occur during quarantine and before they go out for the first time during the self-initiated epidemic prevention period.

'UPBEAT' MARCOS HITS THE GROUND RUNNING



Less than a week after assuming office, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr., has been "upbeat" about his job. Press Secretary Rose Beatrix "Trixie" Cruz-Angeles said the 64-year-old Marcos hit the ground running in the first few days of his presidency.

"How is he settling in? So far he's upbeat. That's the observation that we have made. He's very encouraging," Cruz-Angeles said in her first press briefing in Malacañang. She said Marcos has been "well-received" everywhere he went so far, including Monday's flag-raising ceremony at the Palace. Briefly addressing those attending the ceremony, the President expressed elation over their enthusiasm and encouraged them to always give their best since that is what the people expect of them.

COVID RISE IN NCR TO PEAK IN 2 WEEKS

The rise in the number of Covid-19 cases in the National Capital Region (NCR) and surrounding regions is expected to peak within the next one to two weeks, the independent monitoring group OCTA Research said.

OCTA said the current increase in Covid-19 cases has exceeded projections, with infections going above the 1,000 mark for the fourth straight day.

The Department of Health recorded 7,398 cases from June 27 to July 3, or a daily average of 1,057 cases. This is higher than the figure from June 20 to June 26.

The NCR or Metro Manila still has the highest number of cases as of July 3 with 663, with 142 cases in Quezon City alone. Cavite, Iloilo, Laguna, Rizal and Cebu all recorded more than 50 cases.

COVAX TO DELIVER 17M MORE VAX DOSES AFTER PRRD ADMIN

The Philippines will receive at least 17 million more doses of coronavirus vaccines from the World Health Organization-led COVAX facility after the end of President Rodrigo Duterte's term. Secretary Carlito Galvez Jr., chief of the National Task Force Against Covid-19 (NTF), bared the COVAX commitment Monday night when he welcomed 299,520 doses of Pfizer jabs at Ninoy Aquino International Airport Terminal 3 with United States Embassy Manila Chargé d'Affaires Heather Variava.



The jabs were donated by the US government through COVAX and was the final vaccine delivery under the Duterte administration. Galvezthanked the US government as well as other partner nations for helping the Philippines ensure a steady supply of Covid-19 vaccines.

The Philippines received a total of 245,382,600 doses under Duterte's watch, with 35.6 million doses donated by the US government out of the 74.2 million from COVAX. "We believe that all of the milestones we have achieved under our national vaccination program are the result of the convergence of efforts of all stakeholders – line agencies, local government units, the private sector, and the international community. Through this strong partnership, we have made the seemingly impossible, possible," Galvez said. Galvez hopes the Marcos administration will build on the US-Philippine partnership, especially in terms of the Covid-19 pandemic response.

Pre-departure COVID-19 test is no longer required for the following travelers:

- ✓ Foreign and Filipino nationals 18 years and above
 - · Should be fully vaccinated; and
 - · Should have received at least one COVID-19 vaccine booster shot
- Foreign and Filipino nationals below 12 years old
 - If parents or guardians are fully vaccinated and have received at least one (1) covid-19 booster shot – COVID-19 test result is NOT REQUIRED upon entry
- Foreign and Filipino nationals 12-17 years old
 - · Should be fully vaccinated

Travel Insurance

 Not required for foreign nationals but is highly encouraged upon entry





