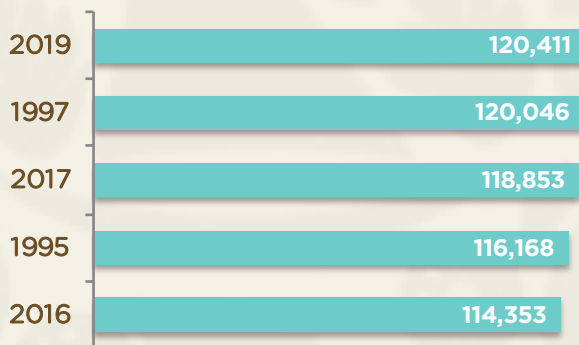
## DID YOU KNOW?

There were **-69.7% fewer flights** to Guam in **May 2020** (272 flights) versus May 2019 (899 flights).

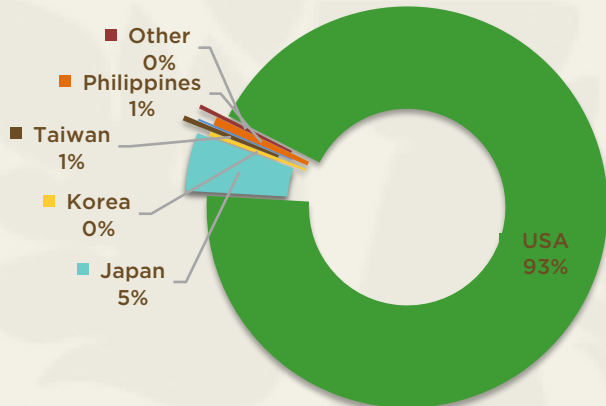

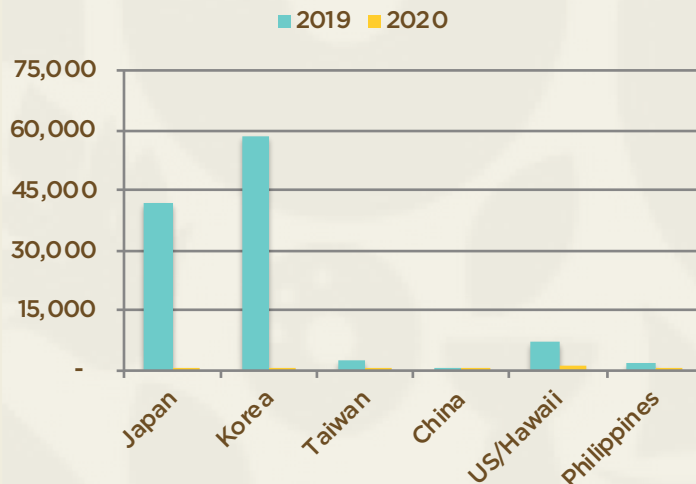

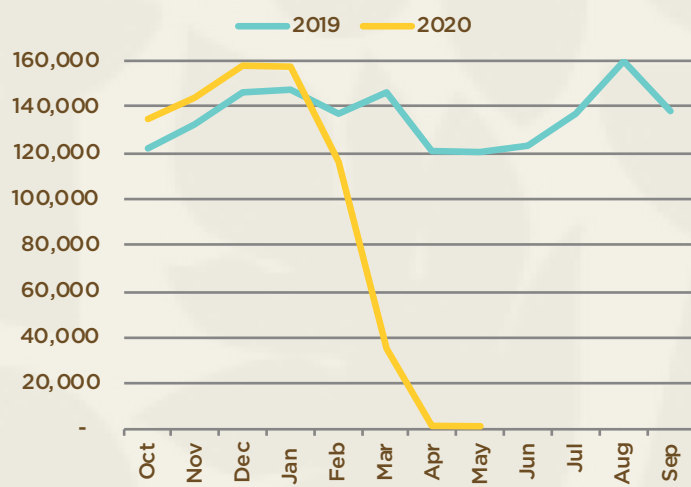
