## WHAT ARE THE DAYS AND TIMES FOR GMIF?

Wednesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> & Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> | 5 PM to 9 PM  
Friday, May 4<sup>th</sup> & Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> | 5 PM to 11 PM  
Sunday, May 6<sup>th</sup> | 5 PM to 9 PM

## WHERE CAN I GET A VENDOR BOOTH APPLICATION?

Applications will be available for download at [guamvisitorsbureau.com](http://guamvisitorsbureau.com) or for pick up at GVB.

## WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION FOR VENDOR CONSIDERATION?

Deadline for application submission to GVB is on March 28, 2018.

## WHAT ARE THE FEES TO BE A VENDOR?

Vendor fees vary by category. Please view the category fees on the Vendor Application.

## WHAT IS THE BOOTH SIZE AND WHAT DOES IT INCLUDE?

Booth will be a canopied (1) one 10 ft x 20 ft space —OR— (1) one shared 16 ft x 24 ft concrete hut. Concrete huts are max of (2) two vendors per hut. All spaces will include overhead lighting and (1) one electrical outlet.

## CAN I STILL REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL POWER OUTLETS?

Yes. While all vendor booths will include (1) one electrical outlet, you may request for additional power. Vendors requesting additional power will be contacted after application has been approved for fee and payment arrangements.

## CAN I SELL SOFT DRINKS, BOTTLED WATER OR BEER?

No. Please refer to application for guidelines.

## CAN I FAX MY APPLICATION?

Applications submitted via fax will not be accepted. Please submit your signed application to GVB along with the applicable fees and deposit. Please make (3) three separate checks for (1) the booth fee, (1) trash deposit and (1) GFD assembly permit.

## WHEN IS PAYMENT DUE?

The applicable fees and deposit are due upon notification of selection as a vendor. Please make two (2) separate checks: one (1) for the booth fee and GFD assembly permit and one (1) for trash deposit.

## WHAT LICENSES AND PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR SALES TRANSACTIONS?

GFD Permit (will be coordinated by GMIF), Temporary Business License, Temporary Health Certificate\* and Sanitary Permit\* (applicable only to food & beverage vendors). Food trucks also require a Peddler's Permit.

## WHEN WILL I BE NOTIFIED IF MY APPLICATION HAS BEEN APPROVED?

Applicants will be contacted by March 30, 2018 upon approval.

## WILL THERE BE A VENDOR MEETING?

Yes, a Vendor Meeting is scheduled for April 10, 2018 and you will be notified in advance.
