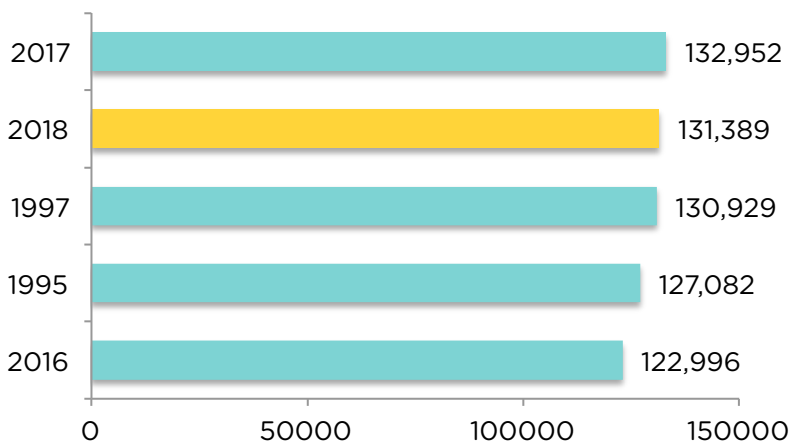

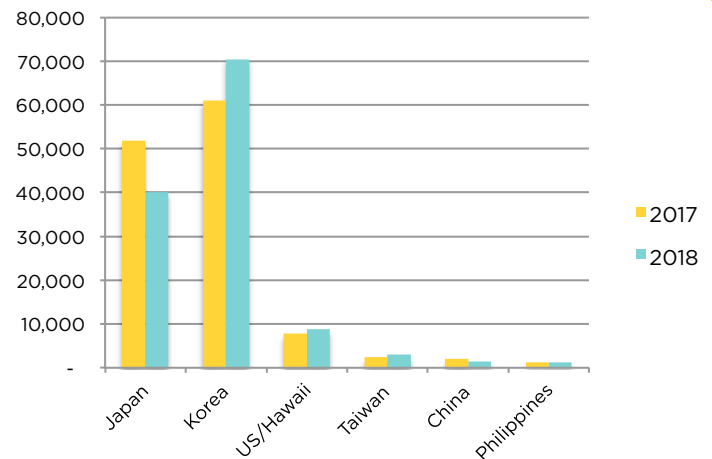

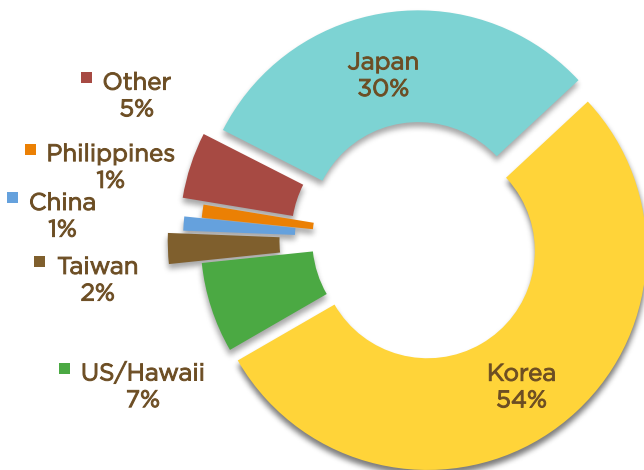
## Top 5 July Arrivals
