**End of Day Results: Eleven Test Positive for COVID-19 by DPHSS**

COVID-19 test results are reported from multiple labs at varying times of the day. The cumulative total from all labs will be reported on a nightly basis, unless unavailable. The following breakdown provides cumulative COVID-19 test results for **Wednesday, May 20, 2020**:

The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) tested 64 individuals for COVID-19 on Wednesday, May 20, 2020 with conclusive results. 11 tested positive through DPHSS and 53 tested negative for SARS-CoV-2.

To date, there have been **165 cases** confirmed through COVID-19 testing provided with **5 deaths** and **125 released from isolation**. Cases are released from isolation under the following conditions: resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications AND improvement in respiratory symptoms AND negative results from two consecutive respiratory specimens collected at least 24 hours apart. Cases that test positive for COVID-19 through follow-up testing return to active isolation. All remaining cases are in isolation.
