**End of Day Results: Zero Test Positive for COVID-19 by DPHSS**

The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) tested 227 individuals for COVID-19 on Sunday, June 28, 2020 with conclusive results. Zero tested positive through DPHSS and 227 tested negative for SARS-CoV-2. Results include 59 samples from COVID-19 drive-through testing held at the St. Francis church parking lot in Yona on Thursday.

To date, there have been a total of **248** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **179** released from isolation, and **64** active cases. Of those cases, **206 are classified as civilians**, and **42 are military service members**.
