One case tested positive at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) and did not report recent travel or contact to a confirmed case.

To date, there have been a total of **314** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **214** released from isolation, and **95** active cases. Of those cases, **267 are classified as civilians** and **47 are military service members**.
