To date, there have been a total of **314** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **222** released from isolation, and **87** active cases. Of those cases, **267** are classified as civilians and **47** are military service members.

Expanded COVID-19 Testing Continues

The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), in collaboration with the Government of Guam, the Mayors Council of Guam, private, and federal agencies, continues expanded COVID-19 testing.

Testing is free and open to the public while supplies last. No symptoms are needed to qualify for testing. If your village is not listed, please proceed to a neighboring village for testing. Please bring an I.D., if one is available. The expanded testing schedule is as follows:

COVID-19 Drive-Through Testing:

- Wednesday, July 22, 2020, 9 a.m. 12 p.m. at the Tamuning Elementary School
 - Free and open to everyone while supplies last
- Thursday, July 23, 2020, 9 a.m. 12 p.m. at the Asan-Maina's Mayor's Office
 - Free and open to everyone while supplies last
