**Cumulative Results: Two Test Positive for COVID-19; Profiles of Confirmed Cases;
 Expanded COVID-19 Testing Continues; Southern Region Community Health Center
 Temporarily Closes; 2020 Census Guam Update**

Two cases tested positive at Diagnostic Laboratory Services (DLS). These cases are currently under investigation.

To date, there have been a total of **356** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **304** released from isolation, and **47** active cases. Of those cases, **307 are classified as civilians** and **49 are military service members**.

Expanded COVID-19 Testing Continues

DPHSS, in collaboration with the Government of Guam, the Mayors Council of Guam, private, and federal agencies, continues expanded COVID-19 testing.

Testing is free and open to the public while supplies last. No symptoms are needed to qualify for testing. If your village is not listed, please proceed to a neighboring village for testing. Please bring an ID, if one is available. The expanded testing schedule is as follows:

COVID-19 Drive-Through/Walk-In Testing:

- Tuesday, August 4, 2020, 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. at the Ordot-Chalan Pago Mayor's Office (in front of Agueda Johnston Middle School)

Southern Region Community Health Center Temporarily Closes

The Southern Region Community Health Center (SRCHC) in Inarajan closed temporarily beginning Thursday, July 30, 2020 due to the lack of working air conditioners in the facility and for the health and safety of the staff and visitors. Parts to repair the air conditioners are expected to arrive on island by the end of the first week of August. The SRCHC will reopen as soon as the air conditioners are repaired.
