Of the seven newly confirmed cases, one case was identified through contact tracing; three cases had recent travel to the continental US and were identified in a quarantine facility; and four cases are under investigation.

To date, there have been a total of **375** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **318** released from isolation, and **52** active cases. Of those cases, **326 are classified as civilians** and **49 are military service members**.

#### Food Commodity Distribution on Thursday Canceled

The Guam Department of Education (GDOE), State Agency for the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) under the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Nutrition Service (FNS), has canceled the TEFAP food commodities distribution scheduled for Thursday, August 6, 2020. This will allow staff to prepare for the reopening of schools and to meet with mayors to discuss an alternate distribution model. The new distribution schedule will be announced at a future date.
