Of the fourteen newly confirmed cases, two cases had recent travel to the continental US. One case was identified in a quarantine facility. The remaining cases are currently under investigation.

To date, there have been a total of **389** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **319** released from isolation, and **65** active cases. Of those cases, **340 are classified as civilians** and **49 are military service members**.
