The eight recently confirmed cases are currently under investigation. Among the six cases confirmed by the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), one case had recent travel to the continental US, two cases were identified through contact tracing, and three cases were identified through community screening.

To date, there have been a total of **397** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **321** released from isolation, and **71** active cases. Of those cases, **348** are classified as civilians and **49** are military service members.
