Twelve cases tested positive at the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). One case tested positive at Diagnostic Laboratory Services (DLS). One case tested positive at Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH).

Of the twelve cases that tested positive at DPHSS, one case had recently traveled to the continental US and was identified in a quarantine facility, eight cases were identified through contact tracing, and one case was identified through community screening. The remaining cases are currently under investigation.

To date, there have been a total of **411** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **321** released from isolation, and **85** active cases. Of those cases, **362** are classified as civilians and **49** are military service members.
