A total of six cases of COVID-19 were confirmed today. One tested positive at the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS). This case was identified through contact tracing. One case tested positive at Diagnostic Laboratory Services (DLS). Four cases tested positive at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA). These cases are under investigation.

To date, there have been a total of **418** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **5** deaths, **325** released from isolation, and **88** active cases. Of those cases, **369** are classified as civilians and **49** are military service members.
