Of the 112 newly reported cases, 24 cases were identified through contact tracing.

One COVID-19 case was identified and reported deceased at Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) on August 27; this case will be officially included in tomorrow's surveillance dashboard.

To date, there have been a total of **1,232** confirmed cases of COVID-19 with **10** deaths, **456** not in isolation, and **766** cases in active isolation. Of those cases, **1,049** are classified as civilians and **183** are military service members.
