DPHSS Postpones Umatac Community Testing Due to Inclement Weather

For the safety of the staff, nurses, responders, and the community, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has **postponed** the COVID-19 community testing, originally scheduled for today, September 19, from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., at the Umatac Mayor's Office due to inclement weather.

A revised date will be provided once available. Those who have pre-registered for today's testing will be notified directly and will be able to keep their reserved spots once a new date has been determined.

DPHSS, in collaboration with the Government of Guam and the Mayors' Council of Guam, will continue to work to provide COVID-19 testing to the community.

Those experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19, are advised to call their health care provider. If a patient does not have a regular health care provider, they can call the Northern Region Community Health Center (NRCHC) at (671) 635-7525/6 to schedule an appointment. The NRCHC COVID-19 testing is available by appointment only.
