KO'KO' WEEKEND RETURNS

Both the Guam Ko'ko' Road Race and the Guam Ko'ko' Kids Fun Run have been GVB signature events for more than 10 years and will be held at Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park (Ypao Beach).

The 13th annual Guam Ko'ko' Road Race is scheduled for April 16, 2023, with the start and finish restored to the event's home in Tumon. This year, the race will offer a 10K out-and-back run/walk course. Event participants will enjoy a new course route that will start in front of the GVB Office and proceed toward Chalan San Antonio, continuing down to Marine Corps Drive with a turnaround point in East Agana and then returning back to Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park (Ypao Beach).

Runners can also anticipate water stops, cheering groups and entertainment along the course route. All participants will receive a finisher's t-shirt and medal.

Predeparture Travel COVID-19 Tests

The Northern Region Community Health Center in Dededo also offers COVID-19 testing for travel predeparture needs at a minimal cost of \$40 and is limited to 10 persons a day. Payments (cash or credit card) are accepted at the (Dededo) clinic cashier's window from Monday to Friday at 8 a.m. Payments will be required on the day of testing. Patients will need to bring a copy of their receipt as proof of payment, along with a valid ID and proceed to the testing site in the NRCHC front parking lot.

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



JAPAN

Traveler entering Japan from Guam will be exempted from submitting negative certificate if they have received three times or more vaccinations.

REQUIREMENTS

- If you have been vaccinated three (3) times of Covid-19 vaccine, you will be exempted from submitting a negative certificate when returning to Japan.
- If NOT, negative result of COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to departure (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, TRC, Smart Amp, NEAR, Next Generation Sequence, CLEIA/ECLIA).
- Submit a written pledge that you will follow the Japanese authorities requirements and fill out questionnaires.
- Install mobile application (MySOS, Google Maps, COCOA; travel insurance for COVID-19 related issues recommended.

SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer subject to quarantine, regardless of vaccination status (as of June 8, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers entering South Korea must register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal.
- Foreigners must apply for Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) if they do not already have it. K-ETA is valid for 2 years from the date of approval, or when the passport used to apply expires, whichever comes first.
- COVID-19 testing is no longer required before departure (as of September 3, 2022) and no longer required upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

- Effective March 20th, the 0+7 self-health management scheme is provided as guidance, and members of the public are free to decide whether to follow it. No relevant penalties will be imposed.
- In addition, Taiwan will also discontinue the Contact Tracing Self-reporting System for Confirmed Cases, remote consultations for home care, self-initiated prevention measures for household members of confirmed cases and arrivals, and updating of COVID-19 diagnosis and test data on the Digital COVID-19 Certificate system (DVC) and My Health Bank and will adjust video consultation protocols in response to COVID-19.

PHILIPPINES

Effective October 4, 2022, as per IATF Resolution No. 2 (s. 2022) on the ENTRY, QUARANTINE and TESTING requirements of inbound travelers to the Philippines:

FULLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

No pre-departure COVID-19 Test requirement - Must have received the 2nd dose in a 2-dose series or a single dose COVID-19 vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation.

UNVACCINATED or PARTIALLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

- Travelers 15 years and older shall present a remotely supervised/laboratory-based Rapid Antigen Test administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, or other similar establishment taken 24 hours prior to the date and time of departure from country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided that, he/she has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over.
- Travelers 15 years and older who fail to present a negative pre-departure testing shall be required to undergo a laboratory-based Antigen Test UPON ARRIVAL at the airport.
- 3. ACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the quarantine protocols of their parent/s or an accompanying adult/guardian traveling with them.
- 4. UNACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the protocols set forth in Section B (1) and (2) above. NOTE:- Any inbound traveler, whether Filipino or Foreign national, who shall test positive for COVID-19 through rapid antigen test shall be subjected to the latest prevailing quarantine and isolation protocols of the DOH.



ENTRY PROTOCOLS

- As of June 12, 2022, the submission of a negative PCR test certificate upon departure from Japan will no longer be required.
- Effective September 7, 2022 the 72-hour corona test required upon entry and return to Japan will be waived only if the patient has already been vaccinated three times.
- For those who have received two or fewer vaccinations, a PCR test (negative proof) within 72 hours prior to local departure is still required.
- Effective October 11, 2022, the daily entry limit was eliminated.

COVID-19 STATUS: COMPARISON WEEK BY WEEK



DAILY CASE

The number of daily infections are hovering 10,000 throughout April, continuously showing the downward trend since January.

WEEKLY CASE

South Korea posted a slight uptick in new COVID-19 cases, as a rise in unmasked gatherings increased amid warmer weather.

MONTHLY CASE

The steady virus trend came as South Korea is preparing for the next post-pandemic phase, in which it will treat the disease as endemic.

CURRENT SITUATION

With most health restrictions having been lifted, the government is closely monitoring daily virus caseloads as outdoor leisure activities have risen across the country.



SPECIFIC ISSUES IN KOREA

KOREA MOVES TO SHORTEN COVID-19 ISOLATION PERIOD TO 5 DAYS

The government is considering shortening the mandatory COVID-19 isolation period to five days from the current seven in May at the earliest, as part of efforts for the transition to an endemic phase.

Along the way, the COVID risk alert will be reduced from "serious" to "caution" in late April, when the World Health Organization is expected to declare the end of the "public health emergency of international concern."





SPECIFIC ISSUES IN KOREA

S. KOREA TO ALLOW ONLINE PERMIT-FREE ENTRY FOR TOURISTS FROM 22 NATIONS INCLUDING U.S.

South Korea will exempt people from 22 visa-waiver nations including U.S., Japan and Taiwan, from mandatory online travel permits and transit visa requirements by the end of 2024 if they visit the country for sightseeing and attending events.

It is as part of efforts to attract more foreign tourists and boost domestic demand, aimed at attracting 10 million foreign tourists this 2023 and revitalizing the economy amid an economic slowdown.





TRAVEL TRADE UPDATE

YANOLJA'S ACQUISITION OF INTERPARL APPROVED BY FAIR TRADE COMMISSION

Yanolja's acquisition of Interpark's travel business has been approved by the Fair Trade Commission, without any corrective measures.

The commission's assessment said that the acquisition does not raise concerns about limiting competition in related markets for online booking platforms, online air ticket booking and issuing. Yanolja plans to leverage Interpark's strengths in concert and air tickets to offer various travel services and expand into the global market.



HAWAII CONSIDERS VISITOR CHARGE TO COMBAT ENVIRONMENTAL COST OF TOURISM

Hawaii may become the first U.S. state to introduce a tourism fee to alleviate the effects of overcrowding and to restore the environment.

Hawaiian Governor Josh Green originally pitched a \$50 fee for tourists to enter the state while there are concerns about the legislation being unconstitutional. Hawaii lawmakers are considering legislation that would require tourists to pay for a yearlong license or pass to visit state parks and trails.

TAIWAN RECORDS 675 NEW COVID-19 CASES, 175 DEATHS OVER PAST

WEEK

Taipei, March 30 (CNA)
Taiwan reported 675
new COVID-19 cases and
175 deaths from the
disease from March 24
to March 30, according
to the Central Epidemic
Command Center
(CECC) Thursday.



The 675 infections reported over the last week involved only moderate and serious cases because people with mild symptoms were no longer requested to self-report by the CECC. All but three of the 675 cases were domestically transmitted, the CECC said.


Also on Thursday, the CECC announced that it would expand the use of the prophylaxis antibody Evusheld to prevent infected atrisk individuals from developing severe symptoms. According to the CECC data, Taiwan has 7,128 doses of Evusheld in stock, which will expire on Nov. 30.

12th ROUND OF NAME-BASED RATIONING SYSTEM FOR AT-HOME COVID-19 RAPID TEST KITS TO BEGIN ON APRIL 1

On March 30, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced that the 12th round of the name-based rationing system for at-home rapid test kits will begin on April 1 to increase access to rapid tests.

The CECC pointed out that as there is a stable supply of rapid tests, each round of the rapid test distribution system lasts for a month. In each round, people who have a National Health Insurance card or Resident Certificate are eligible to purchase rapid tests at NHI-contracted pharmacies or public health centers. Each eligible individual can purchase up to six packs of rapid tests (30 test kits) at a time or different times (no limit) and can have a person purchase on their behalf. One pack (five test kits) is still priced at NT\$500.

THIRD WAVE OF OMICRON INFECTIONS CONTINUES TO SUBSIDE WITH AVERAGE OF 96 NEW DOMESTIC CASES (COMPLICATIONS) PER DAY; CECC CONFIRMS 30 NEW CASES OF OMICRON SUBVARIANTS

On March 30, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) reported an average of 96 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 (with complications) per day from March 24 to 30 after relaxed pandemic prevention measures became effective on March 20. This average of moderate to severe cases per day was slightly lower than the daily average of 119 cases in the month prior to the implementation of the new epidemic prevention scheme. Also, there were three new imported cases.

The CECC also reported an average of 25 deaths per day in the last week, a number that was lower than the daily average of 34 deaths in the week before last week (March 17-23).

COMPETITORS

Singapore: Through its official social media channels, Changi Airport has just announced that starting on April 3, the Free Singapore Tour Services will resume. The fascinating tours under three hours had been suspended for over two years due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but now travelers can choose from great tour options in under 3 hours. Eligible passengers – certain requirements must be met – can choose from the Changi Precinct Tour, The City Sights Tour, the Jewel Tour, and –starting in June this year – the Heritage Tour. At the airport, passengers will have three bus tour itineraries available that last 2.5 hours. Organizers expect to increase tour options to up to 9 experiences a day. (Apr 5)

Korea: Officials in South Korea will temporarily lift electronic travel authorization (K-ETA) requirements for 22 visa-free locations from April 1. The exemption will apply to Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, Macau, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Taiwan, UK, and US. Authorities did not specify the duration of the exemption. Passport holders from other visa-free countries not included in the list must continue to apply for K-ETA at least 72 hours prior to entry. (Mar 30)

Hong Kong: As overseas tourists and large-scale events return to Hong Kong, Lan Kwai Fong has partnered with The Department of International Trade Promotion, Ministry of Commerce of Royal Thai Government to present a sensational Thai cultural celebration unlike any other. During mid-April each year, families and friends gather around to celebrate Songkran (Thai New Year) by having water blessing ceremonies and paying gratitude to their elders. The inaugural Thai SELECT Carnival 2023 will transform the Streets of Lan Kwai Fond into a mini-Thailand for one day only on Saturday, 22 April. (April 01)

Japan: Hainan Airlines said on Monday it plans to resume the route from Xi'an to Tokyo from April 12, and the frequency will be increased to three times per week starting on May 2 from once per week. China Southern Airlines said on Saturday that it will gradually resume several routes from Chinese cities to Tokyo and Osaka in Japan from April 1 due to rising demand and the recovery of the travel market. The routes to Japan operated by China Southern will reach 64 flights per week. Japanese airline All Nippon Airways also said it will restart its connections from Beijing and Shanghai to Tokyo from April 1. The route between two airports in Shanghai and Tokyo will offer one flight per day, and the route to Beijing will be increased to daily flights from April 10. (Apr 04)

RESORTS WORLD ONE ARRIVES AT KAOHSIUNG IN SOUTH TAIWAN FOR FIRST VOYAGE TO HONG KONG

Resorts World One cruise ship arrived on Tuesday (April 4) at Port of Kaohsiung for its voyage from the southern Taiwan port, CNA reported. Resorts World One has launched a Kaohsiung and Hong Kong dual home port itinerary starting from April. The cruise ship departs from Kaohsiung for Hong Kong twice a week. The 4-day, 3night voyage departing from Kaohsiung on Monday will go to Hong Kong via Penghu. per CNA. Resorts World Cruises in the first company to set up dual homeports in Taiwan after the COVID-19 epidemic was lifted, company president Wu Mingfa said during a ceremony to mark the first voyage from Kaohsiung on Tuesday. According to Wu, Resorts World One will make 78 calls at Kaohsiung this year, which is expected to bring 140,000 international passengers and generate roughly NT\$1.68 billion (US\$55.55 million) in tourism dollars. he added, per CNA. (Apr 04)

METRO MANILA'S COVID-19 POSITIVITY RATE RISES TO 6.5 PCT-OCTA



Metro Manila's COVID-19 positivity rate or the percentage of tests turning out positive for the virus rose in the past week, a think tank said Monday.

According to Dr. Guido David of OCTA Research, the capital region's positivity rate increased to 6.5 percent on April 8 from 4.4 percent recorded on April 1.

The World Health Organization recommends a 5-percent threshold for COVID-19 positivity rate. Last week, the Department of Health said the increase in COVID-19 cases was not a cause for concern as hospital admissions were manageable.

Since the start of the pandemic, the country has tallied 4,083,678 coronavirus infections. The death toll stood at 66,420. To date, more than 79.1 million are fully vaccinated against COVID-19.



DOH POSTS 1,944 NEW COVID-19 CASES OVER HOLY WEEK

The number of new COVID-19 cases recorded in the Philippines in the past week reached nearly 2,000, according to the Department of Health's (DOH) data on Monday.

There were 1,944 infections reported from April 3 to April 9, 2023, more than the 1,721 cases from March 27 to April 2.

Recent daily case average also went up by 13% from the previous 246 to 278. The DOH also recorded 179 new cases on Monday, bringing the country's overall total to 4,083,842.




