

"South Korea's General Election Held on April 10"



- South Korea held its 22nd general election on April 10, poised to confront a pivotal moment as 300 new members of the National Assembly will be elected.
- The election will not only shape the political landscape of the country for the next four years but also serve as a crucial test for the president, who is currently a conservative.







FORMER CABINET SECRETARY CHO JUNG-TAI NAMED NEW PREMIER

President-elect William Lai on Wednesday tapped former Cabinet secretary-general Cho Jungtai to be the new premier, set to take office after the inauguration on May 20. Lai made the announcement at a news conference in Taipei, at which he unveiled the slogan "an active and innovative Cabinet," or "Al" Cabinet.

Cho served as Cabinet secretary-general from 2017 to 2018 under Lai as premier. He was also elected chair of the Democratic Progressive Party following its defeat in the 2018 local elections. During his tenure from 2019 to 2020, Cho played a key role in navigating a contentious primary race between Lai and President Tsai Ing-wen.

Cho is known as being a relatively soft-spoken negotiator, with more than three decades of experience in government as a city councilor, legislator, presidential secretary-general and Cabinet member. More recently, Cho was a member of a "study group" convened by Lai that helped formulate the candidate's national infrastructure platform and served as a key member of Lai's presidential campaign, organizing overseas support organizations.

At the event, Lai also named former minister of culture Cheng Li-chiun as vice premier, National Development Council Minister Kung Ming-hsin as secretary-general and former Taichung city councilor Chen Shih-kai as spokesman.

PRESIDENTIAL AID IN LIN CHIA-LUNG TIPPED TO BE TAIWAN'S NEW FOREIGN MINISTER

Presidential aide and former Taichung Mayor Lin Chia-lung is tipped to be Taiwan's next foreign minister, replacing Joseph Wu, a source with knowledge of the matter told CNA Thursday. It was reported in the local media that President-elect Lai Ching-te met with Lin, secretary-general to the President, on Thursday, during which Lin agreed to take up the post of foreign minister.

A source close to Lin confirmed to CNA that "there was a meeting and Lin had agreed to become foreign minister," but the appointment is pending formal announcement. Lin is expected to take up the post after Lai and Vice President-elect Hsiao Bi-khim assume office on May 20, following their win in January's presidential election. Lai announced Wednesday that former ruling Democratic Progressive Party (DPP) Chairman Cho Jung-tai will be the premier in his administration.

Lin, 60, has been serving as secretary-general at the Presidential Office since January 2023, after he lost his bid to unseat New Taipei Mayor Hou Yu-ih of the opposition Kuomintang (KMT) in late 2022. Before Lin was appointed as an aide to President Tsai Ing-wen he was ambassador-at-large in charge of Taiwan's digital New Southbound Policy initiatives, which were introduced by Tsai to enhance trade and exchanges between Taiwan and 18 countries in Southeast and South Asia, as well as Australia and New Zealand. Alongside that, Lin began his political career in the early 2000s, serving in various positions in the administration of then President Chen, including an advisor to the National Security Council and Cabinet spokesman. He also served as secretary-general of the DPP and as deputy secretary-general at the Presidential Office during Chen's presidency

TOURISTS FROM BRUNEI ARRIVE IN TAIWAN EARTHQUAKE REGION

Despite the fear of aftershocks, more than 80 tourists arrived in Hualien County Tuesday (April 9) on a charter flight straight from Brunei. A magnitude 7.2 earthquake on April 3 caused widespread devastation in the county, leaving at least 13 people dead and six missing. Major roads across the region have been blocked by rockfalls, with more than 800 aftershocks occurring over the past week.

Even though the disaster led to fears that Hualien's tourism sector would lose NT\$5.3 billion (US\$165 million), charter flights from overseas are still scheduled to go ahead this month. The first one was a Royal Brunei Airlines Airbus A320 with more than 80 people on board, which landed at Hualien Airport Tuesday. The visitors will spend three days and two nights in the county, per CNA.

They will visit the Dongdamen night market in Hualien City, Qixingtan Beach, Liyu Lake, and the Farm Dream Estates in Fenglin Township. Taroko National Park will not be on their itinerary, as it bore the brunt of the earthquake. The local authorities said they had high hopes that the flight from Brunei signaled the start of a tourism revival in Hualien after the earthquake.

On April 12, a direct charter flight from Thailand will arrive, with a flight from Vietnam scheduled for April 27. According to the county government, efforts will continue to arrange similar services from Japan, South Korea, Singapore, and Malaysia directly to Hualien.

JAPAN: Japan has been busier than ever with tourists – and now, flesh-eating bacteria. Officials are trying to ease anxious travelers who are wondering if they should cancel their Japan trip. As the high-mortality disease streptococcal toxic shock syndrome (STSS) spreads, the Ministry of Health says "For individuals planning to travel to Japan, there's no need to cancel travel plans due to the outbreak of this disease." Still, the Ministry's website advises travelers to wear masks and maintain good hygiene. A spokesperson told local newspaper Asahi Shimbun that "as long as basic measures against infection are in place, there's no need to worry."(April 8)

KOREA: Korean Air has confirmed plans to operate seasonal charter services between Seoul Incheon and Taichung, Taiwan. Scheduled for take off on 2 May, the airline will operate the Seoul Incheon-Taichung route with thrice weekly flights on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, up to 29 June 2024. Flight KE189 is slated to depart from Seoul Incheon (ICN) at 15:30, arriving at Taichung (RMQ) at 17:15. From Taichung, flight KE190 is scheduled to leave at 18:50 and arrive at Seoul Incheon at 22:40.(April 8)

<u>AUSTRALIA</u>: The Australian Foreign Ministry has strongly advised its citizens against traveling to Afghanistan, citing an "extremely dangerous security situation and the very high threat of terrorism and kidnapping." According to the Smartraveller—the Australian Foreign Ministry's travel advice website there are no Australian officials in Afghanistan to provide consular and passport services. "There are no Australian officials in Afghanistan, and our ability to provide consular and passport assistance to Australians in Afghanistan is severely limited," the website stated. (April 10) THAILAND: From 1 January to 31 March, Thailand has welcomed a total of no less than 9,370,297 international travelers. Compared to just a year ago, the country has made a surge of 44%. The Thai Ministry of Tourism and Sports, who shared the news in a press release, has also unveiled that this accounted for 454.65 billion baht (11.42 billion euros) in revenue for local entrepreneurs. (April 8)

SINGAPORE: With an inauguration and a water salute, the first Singapore Airlines (SIA) flight for the new service departed from Brussels Airport at 12:10 pm on Saturday. After a 20-year absence, SIA is reconnecting the heart of Europe with this metropolis in Asia. The addition of Brussels increases the number of European gateways in SIA's network to 13, reflecting the airline's commitment to improving connectivity for its customers and offering more choices.(April 6)

PALAU: Palau International Coral Reef Center (PICRC) recently received a grant from the Australian Government through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT). This \$25,000 grant will support PICRC's activities in the topic of "Using Research, Education and Outreach to promote Science and support the management of Palau's Marine Resources". (April 9)

DELEGATE MOYLAN MEETS WITH PRESIDENT MARCOS TO DISCUSS VISA WAIVER AND MEDICARE PORTABILITY

At the invitation of the Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos Jr., Delegate James Moylan joined a few of his colleagues on Friday evening in Washington, D.C., to discuss a variety of issues of importance between the United States and the Republic of the Philippines. Moylan raised the issues on adding the Philippines to the Guam-CNMI visa waiver program and the potential of Medicare Portability for U.S. citizens opting to relocate to the Philippines.

President Marcos expressed his support for both issues and indicated that the Delegate's office should continue to work with the Philippines Department of Foreign Affairs on the matter. Regarding Medicare Portability, Moylan introduced legislation recently to request a study on the cost and savings analysis if U.S. Citizens were to access greater Medicare coverage in the Philippines.

Moylan said, "It was an honor to meet with President Marcos and to get the opportunity to discuss issues key for Guam's relationship with the Philippines. The visa waiver process is ongoing, and this is truly an effort of so many individuals, primarily Governor Carl Gutierrez, who has been a staunch advocate of the issue. I would also like to thank Governor Lou Leon Guerrero and Senator Jesse Lujan for their continued advocacy..."



ROMUALDEZ, HOUSE COLLEAGUES SAY SUMMIT WITH US, JAPAN A BIG WIN FOR PH

MANILA, Philippines – The recently-concluded trilateral summit between the Philippines, United States, and Japan is a big win secured by President Ferdinand "Bongbong" R. Marcos Jr. for the country, House of Representatives Speaker Ferdinand Martin Romualdez and other lawmakers said.

In a statement, Romualdez said that the clear-cut collaboration between the three countries on economic progress, increasing defense capabilities, and maritime security would ensure that the Philippines is ready for whatever regional challenges it may face.

"The collaboration and dialogue fostered during this meeting pave the way for enhanced cooperation in addressing regional challenges, particularly in promoting maritime security, safeguarding our territorial integrity and improving the lives of the Filipino people," Romualdez said on Sunday. He also reiterated that the meeting stresses the need for a rules-based order and a free and open Indo-Pacific Region.









MVA CHIEF SUPPORTS INCLUSION OF PHILIPPINES IN THE GUAM-CNMI VISA WAIVER PROGRAM

Marianas Visitors Authority Managing Director Christopher Concepcion said he supports the inclusion of the Philippines in the Guam-CNMI visa waiver program.

"We're in full support of it. It is not just a Guam visa waiver program; it is a Guam-CNMI visa waiver program," he added. "We really have no control on any federal matters, but we are in support of any effort to allow free access from the Philippines to the CNMI."

Guam Gov. Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero and Lt. Gov. Joshua F. Tenorio requested Joe Biden to include the Guam-CNMI Visa Waiver Program on the agenda at the summit hosted by Biden at the White House where he met with Philippine President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. and Japan Prime Minister Kishida Fumio.

Leon Guerrero and Tenorio said they both recognize the invaluable contributions made by Filipinos to the Guam communities that are vital in strengthening its diverse cultural tapestry and its ties with the broader Pacific region. They also noted that the economy of the Philippines has been rapidly growing.

According to the Guam officials, removing the visa requirement for Filipinos who wish to travel to Guam and the CNMI would stimulate tourism, saying that the spending of Filipino travelers exceeds that of individuals of Guam's primary markets.



BORACAY READIES SECURITY, SAFETY MEASURES FOR TOURISTS THIS SUMMER

ILOILO CITY – The Malay local government has activated its municipal incident management team to monitor tourist arrivals in Boracay Island this summer. "In terms of preparation, we consider our peace and order and security, medical and emergency preparedness, as well as our solid waste management. So far, we are in place already," Malay chief tourism operations officer Felix delos Santos Jr. said on Monday.

Delos Santos said that for this summer, among the big events they are preparing are Love Boracay and a series of international events, sports tourism, and beach activities that are expected to usher more tourists to the island. Love Boracay is the biggest and most highly anticipated annual party season on the island, emphasizing environmental conservation through a series of activities from April 26 to May 1.






