Predeparture Travel COVID-19 Tests

The Northern Region Community Health Center in Dededo also offers COVID-19 testing for travel predeparture needs at a minimal cost of \$40 and is limited to 10 persons a day. Payments (cash or credit card) are accepted at the (Dededo) clinic cashier's window from Monday to Friday at 8 a.m. Payments will be required on the day of testing. Patients will need to bring a copy of their receipt as proof of payment, along with a valid ID and proceed to the testing site in the NRCHC front parking lot.

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



JAPAN

Traveler entering Japan from Guam will be exempted from submitting negative certificate if they have received three times or more vaccinations.

REQUIREMENTS

- If you have been vaccinated three (3) times of Covid-19 vaccine, you will be exempted from submitting a negative certificate when returning to Japan.
- If NOT, negative result of COVID-19 test conducted within 72 hours prior to departure (RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, TRC, Smart Amp, NEAR, Next Generation Sequence, CLEIA/ECLIA).
- Submit a written pledge that you will follow the Japanese authorities requirements and fill out questionnaires.
- Install mobile application (MySOS, Google Maps, COCOA; travel insurance for COVID-19 related issues recommended.

SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer subject to quarantine, regardless of vaccination status (as of June 8, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

- All travelers entering South Korea must register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal.
- Foreigners must apply for Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) if they do not already have it. K-ETA is valid for 2 years from the date of approval, or when the passport used to apply expires, whichever comes first.
- COVID-19 testing is no longer required before departure (as of September 3, 2022) and no longer required upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

- Effective March 20th, the 0+7 self-health management scheme is provided as guidance, and members of the public are free to decide whether to follow it. No relevant penalties will be imposed.
- In addition, Taiwan will also discontinue the Contact Tracing Self-reporting System for Confirmed Cases, remote consultations for home care, self-initiated prevention measures for household members of confirmed cases and arrivals, and updating of COVID-19 diagnosis and test data on the Digital COVID-19 Certificate system (DVC) and My Health Bank and will adjust video consultation protocols in response to COVID-19.

PHILIPPINES

Effective October 4, 2022, as per IATF Resolution No. 2 (s. 2022) on the ENTRY, QUARANTINE and TESTING requirements of inbound travelers to the Philippines:

FULLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

No pre-departure COVID-19 Test requirement - Must have received the 2nd dose in a 2-dose series or a single dose COVID-19 vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation.

UNVACCINATED or PARTIALLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

- Travelers 15 years and older shall present a remotely supervised/laboratory-based Rapid Antigen Test administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, or other similar establishment taken 24 hours prior to the date and time of departure from country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided that, he/she has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over.
- Travelers 15 years and older who fail to present a negative pre-departure testing shall be required to undergo a laboratory-based Antigen Test UPON ARRIVAL at the airport.
- 3. ACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the quarantine protocols of their parent/s or an accompanying adult/guardian traveling with them.
- 4. UNACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the protocols set forth in Section B (1) and (2) above. NOTE:- Any inbound traveler, whether Filipino or Foreign national, who shall test positive for COVID-19 through rapid antigen test shall be subjected to the latest prevailing quarantine and isolation protocols of the DOH.




HIGHLIGHTS



ENTRY PROTOCOLS

- As of June 12, 2022, the submission of a negative PCR test certificate upon departure from Japan will no longer be required.
- Effective September 7, 2022 the 72-hour corona test required upon entry and return to Japan will be waived only if the patient has already been vaccinated three times.
- For those who have received two or fewer vaccinations, a PCR test (negative proof) within 72 hours prior to local departure is still required.
- Effective October 11, 2022, the daily entry limit was eliminated.





- "Gupot Canton Tasi" is an event for hotel guests only, and participation is free. It is only held on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays.







MOST PEOPLE ON TAIPEI MRT SEEN WEARING MASKS DESPITE LIFTING OF MANDATE

Taipei, April 17 (CNA)

The majority of the passengers traveling on Taipei's Blue MRT line Monday morning were seen wearing face masks, despite Taiwan's removal of a mask mandate that had been in effect for more than two years amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

On Monday, the requirement for mask-wearing on public transportation was revoked, which meant that the mandate remained only for medical facilities in Taiwan.



EFFECTIVE APR 17, CECC TO ADJUST SOME VISITATION, RESIDENT MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR RESIDENTIAL LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES DURING COVID-19

On Apr 13, the CECC announced that it will adjust some visitation and resident management measures for long-term care facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic. Details are listed below.

- Visitation management: the requirement for visitors, individuals accompanying patients, and new residents who don't have COVID-19 symptoms and exposure history to take rapid tests will be removed.
- II. Management of the entry and exit of residents: The requirement that new residents and residents who don't have COVID-19 symptoms and exposure history need to take rapid tests and undergo isolation when they return to their facilities after staying overnight outside as well as being admitted to the facilities from the hospital or discharged from the hospital will be removed.

ACIP EXPERTS RECOMMEND EXPANDING ELIGIBILITY FOR MODERNA BIVALENT COVID-19 VACCINE TO INCLUDE CHILDREN 6 MOS THROUGH 5 YEARS OF AGE

On April 13, the CECC reported recommendations on the use of Moderna's BA.4/BA.5 bivalent COVID-19 vaccine as a booster for children. These recommendations are listed below:

- A. Moderna's BA.4/BA.5 bivalent COVID-19 vaccine can be given as a booster to children 6 months through 5 years of age who have completed their primary series of vaccinations.
- B. Modern'as bivalent COVID-19 vaccine is not suitable for use in children 6 months through 5 years of age who have completed their primary series vaccination with the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for children. These children are recommended to follow the current recommendations to receive three primary series doses of Pfizer-BioNTeach vaccine for children.





TAIWAN REPORTS 15 NEW CASES OF MONKEYPOX

- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced Tuesday (April 18) 15 new confirmed cases of monkeypox (mpox), including 13 local cases and 2 imported cases, per PTS.
- As for geographical distribution, 12 cases were reported in the north and 1 case in the south. The ages of those affected ranged from 20s to 40s, with symptoms including fever, swollen lymph glands, blisters, pustules, and rashes.
- The two imported cases came from Malaysia and Japan, affecting one foreign national in his 20s in northern Taiwan, and a Taiwanese individual living in southern Taiwan in his 30s. Both individuals traveled overseas and developed symptoms after returning home.
- The CDC reminded the public that there are still 4,837 mpox vaccines available for registration. Those eligible are requested to register on the mpox vaccination platform as soon as possible to protect themselves and others.





TAIWAN TO OFFER NT\$5,000 SUBSIDIES TO LUCKY FOREIGN INDEPENDENT TRAVELERS FROM MAY

- Beginning in May, Taiwan's Ministry of Transportation and Communications (MOTC) will offer a NT \$5,000 (US\$165) subsidy for international independent travelers who win lucky draw prizes upon their arrival in Taiwan.
- The number of beneficiaries will be limited to 500,000.
- The MOTC on Monday (April 17) said the program is intended to attract more international tourists to Taiwan.
- The lucky draw will take place at the following five locations:
 - Taoyuan International Airport Terminal 1
 - Taoyuan International Airport Terminal 2
 - Taipei Songs shan Airport
 - Taichung International Airport
 - Kaohsiung International Airport

ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES IN PHILIPPINES BACK ABOVE 10,000

The Philippines' tally of active COVID-19 cases climbed back over 10,000 with 287 new infections reported by the Department of Health.

The caseload stood at 10,263, the DOH's COVID-19 tracker showed. Three years since the declaration of COVID-19, the Philippines has recorded 4,086,620 cases.

In a press briefing Tuesday, DOH officer-in-charge Maria Rosario Vergeire noted there was an uptick in the virus tally but hospital utilization remained manageable.



NATIONAL COVID POSITIVITY RATE AT 8.8 PCT: OCTA

The national COVID-19 positivity rate or the percentage of tests turning out positive for the virus has increased to 8.8 percent as of April 20, OCTA Research said Friday.

OCTA Research fellow Dr. Guido David said the Department of Health reported 530 new cases and 1 deaths (1 in NCR), including 1441 recoveries and 7340 active cases.

In an interview with TeleRadyo, David said COVID positivity rate in Metro Manila is currently 8.4 percent.

He said the rise in COVID-19 infections could be attributed to complacency and decrease in observation of health and safety protocols and waning immunity.

DOT EYES MORE FLIGHTS FROM US TO PHILIPPINES

The department of tourism (DOT) aims to add more flights and routes between the United States and the Philippines, declared Tourism Secretary Christina Garcia Frasco.

Aside from partnerships with the airline industry and participation in travel exhibitions in the US. the agency would work with the Department of Transportation to develop the country's travel infrastructure with the target of reducing the overall length of flight time to one's final destination, said Frasco.

US tourists were the Philippines' top visitors in 2022, with 505,089 of the visiting the country, equivalent to 19.03 percent of total tourist arrivals. Meanwhile the country has welcomed 304,289 travelers from the US - or 19.71 percent of total tourist arrivals - as of April 21.

The delegation also met with Senator Jesse Lujan for certificates of recognition at the Guam Legislature.


