OVER 500 APPLICATIONS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED SINCE THE PROGRAM LAUNCHED ON JUNE 14, 2023.



TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



JAPAN

Traveler entering Japan from Guam will no longer be required to submit negative certificate (as of May 12, 2023).

SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to provide COVID-19 testing before departure (as of September 3, 2022) or upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

 OPTIONAL: All travelers entering South Korea may register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal.

TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

PHILIPPINES

Effective October 4, 2022, as per IATF Resolution No. 2 (s. 2022) on the ENTRY, QUARANTINE and TESTING requirements of inbound travelers to the Philippines:

FULLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

No pre-departure COVID-19 Test requirement - Must have received the 2nd dose in a 2-dose series or a single dose COVID-19 vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation.

UNVACCINATED or PARTIALLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

- Travelers 15 years and older shall present a remotely supervised/laboratory-based Rapid Antigen Test administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, or other similar establishment taken 24 hours prior to the date and time of departure from country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided that, he/she has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over.
- Travelers 15 years and older who fail to present a negative pre-departure testing shall be required to undergo a laboratory-based Antigen Test UPON ARRIVAL at the airport.
- 3. ACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the quarantine protocols of their parent/s or an accompanying adult/guardian traveling with them.
- 4. UNACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the protocols set forth in Section B (1) and (2) above. NOTE:- Any inbound traveler, whether Filipino or Foreign national, who shall test positive for COVID-19 through rapid antigen test shall be subjected to the latest prevailing quarantine and isolation protocols of the DOH.

GUAM RANKED 2ND IN POPULARITY AS A SUMMER VACATION DESTINATION!

JTB has compiled a ranking of popular domestic and overseas destinations based on reservations for the summer vacation period (July 15 to August 31, 2023) in anticipation of the first summer vacation since the transition to the Covid-19 5 class.

The total of all overseas travel (unaccompanied) destinations recovered significantly, approximately 202 times compared to the same period in 2022, as the destinations sold during the same period last year were limited to Hawaii and the U.S. Popular destinations, led by Hawaii and Guam, were followed by nearby Asian destinations such as Korea, Taiwan, and Singapore, which ranked high as in 2019. Hawaii was the most popular destination, as was Golden Week this year, with an increase in bookings from couples as well as families and honeymoons, while Guam, in second place, continues to be a strong favorite among families with children. South Korea, in third place, is popular among families as well as female groups. Asia (Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, etc.) is expected to see an increase in last-minute bookings due to the relatively low cost of travel, including the cost of local accommodation, and the short length of the trip, making it easy to schedule.



This year marks the 10th anniversary of the opening of Kracked Egg. Kracked Egg is popular among both tourists and locals, with long lines sometimes forming during busy times. The word "egg" is used in the name of the restaurant, and when it comes to egg dishes, breakfast is the most popular. Of course, lunchtime is also recommended, but Cracked Egg has a full breakfast menu. Here are some of the menu items that will make you want to visit and eat there in the morning. Kracked Egg is located across from Tumon Sands Plaza. It is within walking distance from the center of Tumon. It is a good place to go for a walk in the morning when it is refreshing.

Let's start with a popular menu item, the Hot Cake Mango (\$13.95). The pancake is filled with mango and topped with additional mango compote (additional \$2.50) for a full mango experience. Although not shown in this photo, it comes with a complimentary whipped cream cheese. The pancakes are very fluffy and delicious as expected.

This is the Acai Waffle (\$11.95). The waffle is topped with acai sorbet, banana, strawberries, and granola.

This is another popular menu item. Lox Florentine (\$16.95). It has a nice name, but it is Eggs Benedict with smoked salmon. Semi-cooked poached eggs, hollandaise sauce, and smoked salmon on an English muffin. The moderate saltiness of the smoked salmon enhances the overall flavor and is very tasty.



KOREAN AIR-ASIANA MERGER FACES MORE DELAY

A planned merger of South Korea's top two air carriers is expected to face more delay as the European antitrust authorities have temporarily halted its probe into the \$1.37 billion high-profile deal.

This is the second time European authorities have delayed their decision on the KE-OZ deal, since it first opened its indepth investigation in February. Another two-month grace period is presumed to have been offered to Korean Air.

So far, the deal has received approval from 11 countries, with pending decisions in the US, Europe and Japan.

Behaviors of Korean outbound travelers

Outbox survey shows that 47% Korean tourists are planning for foreign trips in the next 6 months. The three key factors influencing their decision to travel abroad are safety, price, and measures to prevent and control the pandemic. They said they would be willing to pay a lot to get the most complete experience at the property. 39.2% of Korean tourists surveyed preferred the luxury hotel and resort segment. This once again confirms their interest in accommodation.

When Korean tourists need information for their trips, they will search in travel blogs and websites. After getting enough necessary information, most of them will book through online travel agents (OTAs). Due to high travel demand and long disconnection, it is not a surprise that they are willing to spend more for upcoming foreign trips (44.8%).










TAIWAN'S COVID-19 CASES TICK DOWN SLIGHTLY BUT REMAIN ON PLATEAU

Taipei, June 27 (CNA)



The number of serious COVID-19 infections in Taiwan fell slightly week-on-week, but continued on a plateau that has lasted most of June, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) said Tuesday.

From June 21-27, Taiwan recorded a daily average of 232 moderate to severe COVID-19 cases, an 8 percent drop from the previous week's daily average of 253, the CDC reported at a press conference.

CDC Deputy Director General Lo Yi-chun (羅一鈞) said that despite the dip, the current wave of infections is likely still in its peak phase, and may rise slightly in the wake of family get-togethers over the long Dragon Boat Festival weekend. Meanwhile, from June 18-24, the number of COVID-19 fatalities averaged at around 24 per day, down 20 percent from the previous week's average of 30 per day, the agency said.

The CDC added that Taiwan's current COVID-19 surge is being driven by the Omicron subvariant XBB, which is also the dominant strain globally. It has estimated that serious COVID cases account for 1 percent of total infections, meaning that last week, the actual number of daily cases was likely around 23,200.

SUBSIDY FOR COVID-19 HERBAL FORMULA TO END FROM JULY 1: OFFICIAL

Taipei, June 23 (CNA)

The government will stop subsidizing Chingguan Yihau, a locally developed traditional herbal formula for COVID-19, starting July 1, Health and Welfare Minister Hsueh Jui-yuan said Friday.

The formula, proven effective in preventing COVID-19 patients with mild or moderate symptoms from developing severe complications, has been administered under emergency use authorization (EUA) since a spike in local infections in May 2021. It has been dispensed for free to COVID-19 patients aged 65 or above, or those under 65 with diabetes or other chronic conditions for the past 18 months, but that will stop because legislation that authorizes COVID-19 related spending expires on June 30, Hsueh said.

The legislation, passed in May 2021 and called the Special Act for Prevention, Relief and Revitalization Measures for Severe Pneumonia with Novel Pathogens, created a special budget to finance the response to COVID-19, including funds for vaccines and treatments. It also provided funding for loans or subsidies for businesses that were affected by the pandemic. Even though the legislation will expire soon, COVID-19 vaccines will still be subsidized by the government until the end of this year because the funding for that is in place, according to the ministry.

SUBSIDY FOR COVID-19 HERBAL FORMULA TO END FROM JULY 1: OFFICIAL

When the herbal COVID-19 treatment was first offered in May 2021, patients had to pay for it out of their own pockets. That changed in December 2021 following a legislative resolution that it be made free for all patients who wanted to use it.

In August 2022, the government restricted subsidized use of the formula to COVID-19 patients with diabetes, kidney, cardiovascular or other chronic conditions under 65 years old and anyone over 65. That was later expanded, however, to include patients with breathing issues or other concerns from a Chinese medicine perspective. As of June 12, more than 1.71 million COVID-19 patients had used Chingguan Yihau subsidized by the government, accounting for 17 percent of those who contracted the disease, according to Huang Yi-tsau, director-general of the ministry's Department of Chinese Medicine.



A box of the herbal medicine covering a five-day course of treatment costs between NT\$1,500 and NT\$2,700 (US\$48.27 and US\$ 86.88), the department said. Earlier this year, the EUA for Chingguan Yihau was extended to June 2024 to buy more time to keep it available before it obtains formal drug certification, according to a statement Hsueh made in March.

TAIWAN MARKET STATUS

TAIPEI, US TO DISCUSS ADDED AIRPORT SCREENING EXEMPTION

The Ministry of Transportation and Communications is to discuss with the US a plan to expand the baggage screening exemption offered to travelers from the US transiting through Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport to include carry-on luggage, it said yesterday.

The ministry said it hopes the policy will take effect in the second half of the year, adding that it is expected to help US travelers save about 30 to 60 minutes while transiting. In 2019, the US and Taiwan initiated a one-stop security program that allows travelers from the US transiting through Taoyuan airport to not have their checked baggage screened. The one-stop security program also applies to people traveling from Canada or New Zealand and transiting through Taoyuan airport. (June 26)

COVID-19 UPDATE

- Last week, there were an average of 232 daily new local cases of COVID-19 (complications), and an additional 116 cases of the Omicron subtype variant were detected. Regular screening measures for general nursing homes and welfare institutions for the elderly were extended until July 31.
- There is an average of 232 daily local confirmed cases of COVID-19 (complications) in the past 7 days (6/21-6/27), which compared with the previous 7 days (6/14-6/27), the daily average of new cases decreased by 8%. This may be affected by the continuous holiday, and needs to be observed.
- The CDC pointed out that 116 confirmed cases of Omicron subtype variant strains were newly detected. According to recent domestic COVID-19 epidemic statistics, 77% of the complications are elderly people over the age of 65, and most of the complications and deaths have a history of chronic diseases or have not received 3 doses of vaccines.
- Regular screening measures extended until July 31 due to high-risk elderly residents with a positive rate of 1.9%-2.4% (average 2.1%) in care institutions.

- 17 new confirmed cases of monkeypox (Mpox) were added, and people who are eligible for monkeypox vaccination are urged to get vaccinated as soon as possible to protect themselves and others
- The CDC announced today (27th) that Taiwan recorded 17 new local cases of monkeypox (Mpox). A total of 24 high-risk contacts were identified and placed under health education and self-health monitoring for 21 days.
- As of June 26, the CDC reported that 104 medical institutions nationwide are providing vaccination services. To enhance convenience, 11 counties and cities, along with 30 medical institutions, offer evening and holiday outpatient services.
- According to CDC statistics, 58,346 Mpox vaccinations have been administered as of June 26, including 54,647 for high-risk sex workers. Among these, 42,066 individuals have received one dose, while 16,280 have received the second dose.

You can explore different cultures and open your mind to new ways of living while also meeting new people," Bounce wrote in the study. (June 21)

KOREA: The Ministry of Justice in Korea has introduced the e-Group Visa for regular tourists, the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in the Philippines announced Tuesday. Starting June 27, this new visa option will be available for groups consisting of at least three members, including company incentive tour groups, educational tour groups below the collegiate level, and regular tour groups. To qualify for this visa, travelers must plan to enter and exit Korea using the same vessel, flight, or other scheduled means of transportation. Designated travel agencies accredited by the Korean government will handle the e-Group Visa applications on behalf of the travelers. The agencies will submit the applications online through the Korea Visa Portal. Tourists can inquire about the application procedure and requirements with accredited travel agencies. (June 27)

INDONESIA: Indonesia has temporarily suspended a visa-free policy for 159 countries as of June 17 due to disease concerns. Countries from the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), including Brunei, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor Leste, and Vietnam, are exempt from the visa requirement; travelers from these countries can stay in Indonesia for up to 30 days with a valid passport and confirmed departure ticket. Officials did not confirm the duration of the measure. Individuals who wish to extend their stay in Indonesia can apply for Electronic Visa on Arrival (e-VOA), Visit Visa, or Limited Stay Visa. Confirm travel plans to Indonesia. (June 27)

HAWAII: Outrigger Resorts & Hotels will add to investments in its home market of Hawaii with a planned acquisition at Kaua'i Beach Resort & Spa. Located in Līhu'e town on the 'Garden Island' of Kaua'i, the resort spans 25 lush acres of beachfront property and features 350 guestrooms with unparalleled ocean views. The transaction is expected to be completed and closed on 22 August 2023. Once acquired, Kaua'i Beach Resort & Spa will represent an important milestone in OUTRIGGER Resorts & Hotels' ongoing expansion efforts – offering guests a full-service resort on all four of the major Hawaiian Islands. (June 27)

DOH CHIEF WANTS COVID-19 HEALTH EMERGENCY LIFTED

With COVID no longer a serious national health issue, Health Secretary Ted Herbosa is planning to recommend to President Marcos the lifting of the state of public health emergency, but with the alert level system retained.

In an interview, Herbosa said Proclamation No. 922 issued by former president Rodrigo Duterte may now have to be lifted, with "COVID-19 being no longer different from the other diseases the Department of Health (DOH) is monitoring."

"With the World Health Organization (WHO), there is no longer an emergency. So I would actually ask (for) the lifting of the public health emergency," Herbosa said.



NOTICE ON FREQUENT "RED LIGHTNING ALERTS" AFFECTING AIRPORT OPERATIONS

For the safety of all airline passengers during this monsoon season, the Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA) issues "red lightning alerts" when isolated thunderstorms occur in the vicinity of Manila's Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA).

A red lightning alert HALTS all ground operations and aircraft movements at the airport, including boarding, disembarkation, aircraft parking, baggage handling and all support activities.

This may unavoidably lead to delays in flights, baggage release, boarding, deplaning and other airport activities. The activities resume only when the MIAA lifts the red alert.

The mandatory halt of airport operations is a safety measure to protect passengers and personnel when there is lightning activity. We are one with MIAA in ensuring safe and smooth operations.





BIVALENT JABS FROM PFIZER APPROVED FOR SALE, USE IN PH



The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has given the green light to pharmaceutical giant Pfizer to sell and distribute its bivalent COVID-19 vaccines, paving the way for Filipinos to get access to the next-generation jabs even if the country's public health emergency gets revoked.

In a statement on Monday, the FDA said it granted a certificate of product registration (CPR) for Pfizer's Tozinameran + Famtozinameran (15 mcg/15 mcg)/0.3 ml under the brand name Comirnaty Original/Omicron BA.4-5.

The vaccine is suitable for adults and children 12 years old and above.

The CPR for Pfizer's bivalent vaccines was given a five-year validity period, according to the FDA, "after a comprehensive evaluation process [and] extensive clinical trials ... of all scientific data" provided by the drug maker.

A CPR is a license issued by the FDA that allows medical devices, such as COVID-19 medicines and vaccines, to be distributed and sold directly to the consumer.



ABOITIZ DENIES BUYING MAJORITY STAKE IN AIRASIA PHILIPPINES

Aboitiz Equity Ventures (AEV) on Monday denied that it has acquired a majority stake in budget carrier AirAsia Philippines. The group's statement comes after a local broadsheet reported that AEV has become the low-cost airline's majority owner. The newspaper report said the Aboitiz group controls the firm that bought a 60 percent stake in AirAsia Philippines in June.

"We would like to clarify and state that this information is not true and accurate," the company said. The group also said they are "actively verifying" the sources that led to the article's publication.

"We want to assure our stakeholders and the public that any significant developments regarding our company will be communicated and disclosed first by us through official channels," the company added.

The Aboitiz Group in March told the Philippine Stock Exchange that it has allocated P78 billion this year for capital expenditures as it focuses on renewable energy and new businesses,

AEV said its infrastructure unit will be spending almost P32 billion, or 42 percent of the conglomerate's capex budget, to further expand Aboitiz InfraCapital's economic estates, telco towers business, as well as new investments in digital infrastructure.



DOT UNVEILS NEW TOURISM SLOGAN: LOVE THE PHILIPPINES

The Department of Tourism (DOT) unveiled on Tuesday the country's "enhanced" tourism campaign slogan - "Love the Philippines."

The slogan replaces the 11-year-old It's More Fun in the Philippines, almost a year since the Marcos administration announced its intent to come up with one that showcases the "Filipino brand."

"The campaign Love the Philippines is not a mere branding campaign, but rather a call to action to every Filipino citizen to remember the beauty of our country, to honor our past, and to look forward to the future armed with the virtues, (and) values of being a Filipino," Tourism Secretary Christina Frasco said during the launch on the sidelines of the DOT's 50th-anniversary celebration at the Manila Hotel.

"Love the Philippines is a recognition of our natural assets, our long and storied history, our rich culture and diversity," she said.

Frasco expressed hope that the new slogan would sustain interest and bring attention to places not necessarily highlighted in DOT's typical branding campaign.

In a presentation, Marie Adriano, marketing firm DDB Group Philippines' brand and strategic planner, pointed out that "love" is the positive theme travelers associate with the Philippines and is "frequently mentioned in high volume globally."

"While fun remains a positive theme and certainly part of the Pinoy DNA, there's less volume of mentions," she said.


