


TYPHOON MAWAR UPDATES



GVB PROVIDED AID TO ALMOST 5,000 STRANDED VISITORS

- The Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) provided assistance to almost five thousand stranded visitors impacted by Typhoon Mawar during their stay here in Guam.
- GVB reached out to tour agents, local bus companies, hotels, and industry partners to transport visitors and provide a sense of security by covering a portion of the cost of their lodging and meals as they waited the availability of seats on outbound airlines from Guam.
- GVB worked with Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association (GHRA) in reaching out to the tourism industry with these response efforts.
- The Korean Consulate's Office also formed a partnership with GVB for transportation of visitors who needed immediate medical services and volunteers who assisted with translation and medical inquiries.



TYPHOON MAWAR UPDATES



GUAM MEDICAL ASSOCIATION PROVIDED CLINICS LISTING FOR STRANDED VISITORS

- The Guam Visitors Bureau requested the assistance of the Guam Medical Association (GMA) who provided an available list of medical providers available to assist with stranded visitors impacted by Typhoon Mawar.

GOVERNOR LEON GUERRERO ISSUED EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2023-04

- On June 3, 2023, Governor Lou Leon Guerrero issued Executive Order No. 2023-04, relative to declaring a state of emergency due to the water supply shortage caused by Typhoon Mawar.
 - Pursuant to 9 G.C.A § 55.60, individuals should only use water supplied by GWA for authorized uses pertaining to public health, safety, and welfare.
 - Specific unauthorized uses provided in Section 55.60 include:
 - Washing motor vehicles
 - Windows
 - Streets
 - Sidewalks and buildings
 - Executive Order No. 2023-04 shall be effective immediately and shall continue in effect for a period of fifteen (15) days. It shall expire on June 18, 2023, unless otherwise amended or rescinded by further executive order.

FREE COVID-19 COMMUNITY TESTING

Fill out a <u>COVID-19 Testing Patient Assessment Form</u> ahead of time: <u>dphss.guam.gov/covid-19-testing</u>. Drive-through sites may close during lightning and inclement weather.

Predeparture Travel COVID-19 Tests

The Northern Region Community Health Center in Dededo also offers COVID-19 testing for travel predeparture needs at a minimal cost of \$40 and is limited to 10 persons a day. Payments (cash or credit card) are accepted at the (Dededo) clinic cashier's window from Monday to Friday at 8 a.m. Payments will be required on the day of testing. Patients will need to bring a copy of their receipt as proof of payment, along with a valid ID and proceed to the testing site in the NRCHC front parking lot.

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



JAPAN

Traveler entering Japan from Guam will no longer be required to submit negative certificate (as of May 12, 2023).

SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to provide COVID-19 testing before departure (as of September 3, 2022) or upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

All travelers entering South Korea must register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: <u>cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal</u>.

TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

P H I L I P P I N E S

Effective October 4, 2022, as per IATF Resolution No. 2 (s. 2022) on the ENTRY, QUARANTINE and TESTING requirements of inbound travelers to the Philippines:

FULLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

No pre-departure COVID-19 Test requirement - Must have received the 2nd dose in a 2dose series or a single dose COVID-19 vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation.

UNVACCINATED or PARTIALLY VACCINATED (Filipino and Foreign Travelers)

- 1. Travelers 15 years and older shall present a remotely supervised/laboratory-based Rapid Antigen Test administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, or other similar establishment taken 24 hours prior to the date and time of departure from country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided that, he/she has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over.
- 2. Travelers 15 years and older who fail to present a negative pre-departure testing shall be required to undergo a laboratory-based Antigen Test UPON ARRIVAL at the airport.
- 3. ACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the quarantine protocols of their parent/s or an accompanying adult/guardian traveling with them.
- 4. UNACCOMPANIED minors below 15 years of age who are NOT VACCINATED for any reason whatsoever shall follow the protocols set forth in Section B (1) and (2) above. NOTE:- Any inbound traveler, whether Filipino or Foreign national, who shall test positive for COVID-19 through rapid antigen test shall be subjected to the latest prevailing quarantine and isolation protocols of the DOH.

JAPAN COVID-19 NEWS



ENTRY PROTOCOLS

- As of June 12, 2022, the submission of a negative PCR test certificate upon departure from Japan will no longer be required.
- Effective October 11, 2022, the daily entry limit was eliminated.
- For return to Japan, as of April 29, 2023, the requirement to submit a vaccination certificate and the results of a PCR test (negative proof) taken within 72 hours has been abolished.
- As of May 12, visitors will no longer be required to present vaccination certificates for entry into Guam, thus removing any restrictions and returning to the same status as before the pandemic.

QUARANTINE AFTER RETURNING TO JAPAN

(Effective from April 29 for those returning to Japan) No need to submit proof of vaccination or negative PCR test within 72 hours

GUAM TYPHOON COVERAGE IN JAPAN

- Since May 25, several news organizations and web news outlets have reported on Typhoon Mawar in Guam.
- The typhoon situation was reported using video footage from the area, interviews with tourists, and information from social networking sites as sources.
- On May 28, reports on humanitarian aid began to appear in media providing a glimpse of the movement towards recovery.

Guam Visitors Bureau summarizes hotels that reopened after the typhoon (as of June 1); public facilities are working around the clock to restore operations; aggressive expansion to capture summer demand



グアム政府観光局(GVB)は2023年6月1日、台風2号の影響と現状をまとめた。 現地では、台風の直撃により甚大な被害が発生。空港の閉鎖など滞在する観光客 も大きな影響を受けていた。 グアム国際空港は5月29日から通常運航を再開。GVBによると、公共機関は24時間 体制でサービス復旧に向けた作業をおこなっている。グアムホテル&レストラン 協会(GHRA)は、台風後に営業を再開し、ダイニングやテイクアウトを提供して いる施設を発表(下記に掲載)。多くのホテルが、6月中旬までに新規予約の受付 ができるよう、取り組んでいる。

GVBでは「Stay Strong」をスローガンに掲げ、観光誘致に取り組んでいく。現 在、夏の需要喚起に向けた「GOGO! GUAM SUMMERキャンペーン」を実施中 で、地域の旅行会社向けのセミナーやユナイテッド航空とのSNSやテレビ番組を 活用したプロモーションなども展開。日本航空が9月~10月にも成田/グアム線を 週4便運航することも発表していることから、さらなる夏のリゾート旅行の需要強 化をはかる。6月17日にはグアムの現地企業と日本航空と共同で、消費者向けイベ ントの開催も予定している。



Korea drops COVID-19 isolation mandate, closes temporary testing centers



The government has lowered the national crisis level for Covid-19 from "serious" to "alert" as of May 31. Under the revision, people infected with Covid-19 are no longer required to isolate for 7 days.

Most of the restrictions people have faced daily have been lifted but the government will continue to provide financial support for vaccinations, treatment, and hospital admissions. The government will share details on the infection cases on a weekly basis instead of a daily basis from June 5.



TRAVEL TRADE UPDATE

YANGYANG AIRPORT FACES UNCERTAIN FUTURE AS SOLE AIRLINE FILES FOR RECEIVERSHIP



A state-funded Yangyang airport in Gangwon is at risk of being left vacant after Fly Gangwon, the sole airline that operates from the location, revealed its plans to file for court receivership due to the Covid-19 outbreak.

Airport officials announced that they will engage in close discussions with Korea Airports Corporation and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport to explore viable solutions, including arranging alternative flights with other budget airlines at the airport.

SERIOUS COVID-19 CASES UP 30% AS TAIWAN ENTERS 4TH OMICRON WAVE: CDC

Taipei, May 23 (CNA)

Taiwan reported a daily average of 204 moderate to severe COVID-19 cases from May 17-23, representing an increase of around 32 percent over the previous week's daily average of 154, the CC reported at a press conference.

CDC Deputy Director-General Tseng Shu-huai said the rising case numbers showed that Taiwan was entering its fourth wave of infections from Omicron subvariants, which is expected to peak sometime between mid and late June.

The CDC also confirmed Tuesday that from May 31, masks will no longer be required in ambulances


or long-term care facilities, though for a time being, they will still be mandatory in medical facilities, such as hospitals, clinics and pharmacies.



FOURTH OMICRON WAVE CAUSES SPIKE IN TAIWAN COVID CASES

Taipei, May 23 (CNA)

- Taiwan's Centers for Disease Control said serious COVID cases are on the rise due to the Omicron XBB variant replacing BA 2.75 as the dominant virus strain, per a CDC press release.
- Due to a spike in cases, the public is still required to wear masks when going to medical institutions. The public is also encouraged to monitor their health as the CDC expects the fourth COVID Omicron wave to reach its peak at the end of June.
- Last week, the CDC said there were 129 confirmed local COVID-19 Omicron cases. Another 67 cases were imported from overseas.

NOTIFICATION PERIOD FOR SEVERE PNEUMONIA ADJUSTED FROM 24 HOURS TO 72 HOURS

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention announced today (31) that the time limit for notification of the fourth category of notifiable infectious disease "severe specific infectious pneumonia" has been adjusted and relaxed from 24 hours to 72 hours, which will take effect immediately.

If a doctor finds a patient who meets the clinical conditions and testing conditions, he or she should report it within 72 hours according to the new regulations. After the notification, if the doctor evaluates the need for isolation treatment, he or she can be hospitalized for isolation treatment.

17 NEW CONFIRMED CADES OF MONKEYPOX (MPOX)

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention announced today (30) that there were 17 new local cases of monkeypox (Mpox) in China, all of whom were males of their own nationality, 15 cases in northern counties and cities, and 2 cases in central areas, aged between their 20s and 40s. The onset date was between May 11 and May 26.

Due to symptoms such as fever, swollen lymph glands, blisters, and pustules, he was evaluated by a doctor and reported. Diagnosed today. After the epidemic investigation, 19 high-risk contacts were listed, and they have undergone self-health monitoring for 21 days. Since June 23 last year, my country has listed Mpox as a second-class statutory infectious disease. As of today, a total of 128 cases (116 local cases and 12 imported cases) have been diagnosed, of which 60 cases have recovered, 15 cases are still in hospital, 53 cases An example is in home independent health management.

BIVALENT JABS NOW AVAILABLE

MANILA, JUNE 5, 2023

With the bivalent vaccines against COVID-19 finally available in the country, the Department of Health (DOH) advised the eligible population to get a third booster job against COVID-19.

The DOH reported than over 390,000 bivalent vaccine doses donated by Lithuania arrived in the country late Saturday.

DOH officer-in-charge Maria Rosario Vergeire explained that the donated bivalent vaccines will help boost the Philippines' COVID-19 response by providing protection against the original COVID-19 strain, SARS-CoV-2, and Omicron subvariants BA.4 and BA.5.

DOH continues coordinating with the COVAX Facility to get additional doses of bivalent vaccines. Under DOH guidelines on the management and administration of the donated bivalent vaccines, those eligible to receive their third booster shots are health care workers (A1) and senior citizens (A2).

Eligible individuals may be vaccinated with the bivalent vaccines at least four to six months after getting their second booster shots.

COVID-19 POSITIVITY RATE IN NCR DECLINES TO 22%

MANILA - Philippines

The positivity rate or the number of people testing positive for the coronavirus disease 2029 (Covid-19) in the National Capital Region (NCR) has decreased to 22 percent as of May 27.

On Monday, OCTA Research Group fellow Dr. Guido David said the figure was over a 3 percent decrease from the region's positivity rate of 25.7 percent from May 14 to 20.

The positivity rates also decreased in Batangas, Bulacan, Camarines, Cavite, Isabela, Laguna, Rizal, and Zambales. Positivity rates remained high in most of Luzon, stated Dr. Guido.


