



TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



JAPAN

Travelers entering Japan from Guam will no longer be required to submit negative certificate (as of May 12, 2023).

SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to provide COVID-19 testing before departure (as of September 3, 2022) or upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

REQUIREMENTS

 All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal.

TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

PHILIPPINES

On July 22, 2023, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. lifted the state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines.

According to Proclamation No. 297, "All prior orders, memoranda, and issuances that are effective only during the State of Public Health Emergency shall be deemed withdrawn, revoked or canceled and shall no longer be in effect."

As of July 7, presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 are <u>no longer required for international arrivals into the Philippines.</u>

NEW CHITOSE AIRPORT WORLD TRAVEL FESTIVAL

On September 30 and October 1, 2023, the Guam Visitors Bureau participated in the second annual World Travel Festival – a two-day consumer event held at New Chitose Airport. A total of 39 tourism agencies exhibited at this event, which attracted more than 1,500 visitors. GVB Japan team conducted a presentation introducing Guam's charm to customers in Hokkaido. Although there are no direct flights from New Chitose Airport in Hokkaido to Guam, many people were still considering traveling to Guam, confirmed the demand among Hokkaido residents.







ONE GUAM SEMINAR IN SAPPORO

On October 2, 2023, GVB Japan held a Guam seminar in Sapporo. The seminar provided travel agencies with the latest information on Guam and requested their cooperation in increasing the number of travelers from New Chitose Airport with a view to launching charter flights. A total of 26 people from 17 companies, including travel agencies and the Sapporo Tourism Association, attended the seminar in cooperation with JATA Hokkaido Branch Office. The Sapporo Tourism Association, which has a sister-city affiliation with Guam, made remarks about the upcoming 30th anniversary next year and the strengthening of exchange relations.





Very popular with Guam people! Tourists should also check it out - Fokai Shop.


FOKAI is an apparel brand that is extremely popular among Guam's residents, with new products arriving every two weeks. It seems that there are many hidden fans in Japan as well.

There are two (2) locations in Guam - Hagåtña and Tumon. The Tumon store, located on Fujita Road near the Grand Plaza Hotel and the Tumon police station, is recommended as it has a larger selection of products and is more accessible for tourists.

The brand's main items are men's tops. There is a wide variety of designs, all of which are full of love for Guam and Chamorros. The designs are very foot, featuring Guam's location (13° NORTH 144° EAST), the rugged ancient Chamorro man, and dwellings on the latte stone, etc.

There is a full lineup of fashion goods. In addition to shirts, there are bucket hats, caps, bags, socks, etc. The interior of the store is also a must-see. There are various stones, shells, and ropes - all of which are essential to the ancient Chamorro culture.









Mangilao Donne' Festival - another great success!

The Mangilao Donne' Festival took place from September 22 – 24, 2023. The festival was packed with people, food, shopping, and entertainment under Guam's blue skies.

Vendors included BBQ stalls, food trucks, local handmade accessories, and many more. Donne' means chili pepper in Chamorro so many products had chili pepper designs to highlight the festival.







THE TAIWAN TOURISM ADMINISTRATION JOINS HANDS WITH THE BUREAU OF FOREIGN TRADE TO PROMOTE TAIWAN

With the goal of attracting over 6 million visitors to Taiwan in 2023 and accelerating the recovery of Taiwan's MICE industry after the pandemic, the Taiwan Tourism Administration (TTA) has been actively implementing international tourism marketing strategies following its recent restructuring. The TTA, in collaboration with the Bureau of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Economic Affairs, will lead members of the MICE industry to participate in MICE fairs. They will jointly participate in the Incentive Travel & Conventions, Meetings Asia (IT&CMA) scheduled for September 26-28, 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand, with the aim of strengthening the recovery of the New Southbound market.

From January to July 2023, Taiwan welcomed 805,792 visitors from the 18 New Southbound countries for business, exhibition, and tourism purposes. This represents

35.22% of all inbound travelers visiting Taiwan for these purposes. This highlights the importance of TTA's marketing investments and efforts in these countries. Tourism offices from many other countries will also be actively participating at the IT&CMA this year, including the Korea Tourism Organization, the Thailand Convention and Exhibition Bureau, and Hong Kong Tourism Board.

The exhibition's theme this year is the positive impact of MICE partnerships on local communities. Experts will be invited to give speeches on the current recovery of large cruise ships and the challenges and prospects for MICE cruises in the new travel era. Taiwan's joint promotional delegation will include 16 key MICE-related companies consisting of two Professional Conference Organizers (PCOs), one Destination Management Company (DMC), eight travel agencies, two hotels, two event venues, and one airline. They will engage in meetings with international buyers during the IT&CMA.

TOP TAIWAN AIRPORT SEES HOLIDAY TRAFFIC REACH 95% OF PRE-COVID LEVEL



Traffic at Taoyuan International Airport during the upcoming Mid-Autumn Festival will reached 94.7% of levels recorded before the COVID-19 pandemic, the airport operator said Friday (Sept. 22). Even though the Mid-Autumn holiday only lasts three days from Sept. 29 to Oct. 1, and the Double Ten National Day holiday only four days, from Oct. 7 to Oct. 10, bookings for overseas flights have reached a new post-pandemic high, per CNA. According to Taoyuan International Airport Corporation (TIAC), 1.62 million passengers are expected during the full period from Sept. 28 to Oct. 11.

The airlines had scheduled 106 extra flights, 32 of them on the first two days of the period, with peaks of 120,000 passengers per day expected for Oct. 1 and Oct. 8, the company said. On average, 115,000 travelers are predicted to pass through Taiwan's busiest airport during the two-week period.

TIAC expects Taoyuan will handle 30 million passengers for the full year, or 61.6% of the figure for 2019. The estimate also included transit passengers, mostly between North America and Southeast Asia.

TAIWAN TO REACH 2023 TARGET OF 6 MILLION VISITORS EARLY



Taiwan will reach its aim of welcoming 6 million from visitors overseas before the end of the the Tourism vear. Administration said Friday (Sept 29). Before the pandemic. COVID-19 Taiwan registered million visitors per year.

For 2023, the first full year after reopening, the government set a target of 6 million.

Tourism Administration Deputy Director - General Lin Hsin-jen said the number of visitors from Europe and America had reached 75% of levels before the pandemic, which the New Southbound Policy countries exceeding 85%, Radio Taiwan International (RTI) reported. During the next three months, 1.6 million visitors would be enough, meaning the goal of 6 million could be reached earlier than originally planned. The Tourism Administration is working on plans for 2024 and are targeting 12 million visitors next year.

BANGKOK ADORNED WITH DRAWINGS DEPICTING TAIWAN

People traveling on the Bangkok Mass Transit System (BTS Skytrain) or the city's bus network until the end of next month might catch a glimpse of drawings depicting things related to Taiwan, such as tourist hotspots and



popular street foods. The drawings include images of a pair of Formosan bears traveling to see sights such as the giant Buddha statue at Fo Guang Shan Monastery in Kaohsiung and sampling foods such as the notorious stinky tofu.

The creations are by Thai illustrator Rasika Saiseang, better known by her pen name "Yeedin," and were commissions by the Tourism Administration's brand in Bangkok to attract more Thai visitors to Taiwan. Yeedin was invited to Taiwan in early June to gather inspiration for her doodles. She added that most tourists from tend to visit landmarks such as Taipei 101 and coffee shops, which inspired her to showcase parts of Taiwan that are not as well-known.

COMPETITORS

Japan now costs ¥80,000, up from ¥47,250. The price hikes vary from about 65% to 77%. Tourists in Japan will pay more for rail passes after the JR train network raised prices for the first time in four decades, by an average of 70% but even with the big increase, demand is likely to stay strong thanks to a cheaper yen and flow of inbound visitors. From the start of this month, a rail pass offering 14 days of unlimited travel across Japan costs ¥80,000, up from ¥47,250. There are also options for one- and three-week passes, as well as first class. The price hikes vary from about 65% to 77%. (October 4)

KOREA: Korean Air has unveiled plans to resume flights and increase operations during the winter season to select destinations in China, Japan, Southeast Asia, North America and Oceania. The IATA winter season begins on the last Sunday of October and ends on the last Saturday of March every year. The winter 2023 season will be from 29 October 2023 to 30 March 2024. Korean Air's seat capacity, measured in available seat kilometers (ASK), reached approximately 85 percent of pre-pandemic levels in September, and is expected to recover to over 90 percent with the launch of the winter schedule. The airline will launch a new daily service to Phu Quoc, Vietnam's largest island, on 26 November 2023. (October 4)

MALAYSIA: Tourism Malaysia, in collaboration with the Malaysia Aviation Group (MAG), launched its latest brochure – "Fly Borneo Specials Vol.1 – The Adventure Begins Here!", as part of Tourism Malaysia's vigorous efforts in promoting intra- and interstate travel in Sabah, Sarawak and Labuan via airline partners through Firefly and MASwings. More than forty-four thematic holiday packages, from a day trip to a week-long tour, have been created to cater for every interest and age level, including airfare and ground tours. Highlighting Malaysian Borneo destinations, these affordable packages are also compiled in digital and printed brochures for travelers to explore the states' rugged adventures, colorful cultures and exotic flora and fauna. (October 2)

THAILAND: Traveloka is well positioned to play a pivotal role in propelling Thailand's travel and tourism sector into its next phase of growth. The company aims to leverage its position as a consumer-focused regional industry enabler. Recently, The Ministry of Tourism & Sports shared information that Thailand welcomed 19 million foreign tourists from January to September 17, 2023, contributing 795 billion baht (US\$22.26 billion) to the country's economy. With solid momentum for Thailand's travel and tourism industry this year, Traveloka is anticipating even more success heading into 2024. (October 5)



HEALTH PROTOCOL & MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS

- As of August 7, 2023, presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 are no longer required for international arrivals into the Philippines.
- For departing international travelers, vaccination requirements depend on the destination country.

Below are the following requirements for foreigners traveling to the Philippines:

Foreign nationals of non-visa required countries

- · Registration via etravel.gov.ph. This must be filled out within 72 hours from their arrival or travelers can comply upon arrival at the special lanes for eTravel registration.
- A ticket back to the port of origin or the next port of destination outside the Philippines scheduled within 30 from arrival. An Entry Exemption Document (EED) must be secured for those staying beyond 30 days.

HEALTH PROTOCOL & MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS

As of 7 August 2023, following the lifting of the state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines by virtue of Proclamation No. 297 series of 2023, the public is informed of the following protocols on vaccination certificates as conveyed by the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF):

- · For International Arrivals: Presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 is not required. All arriving international travelers are accepted regardless of their vaccination status:
- · For Departing International Travelers: The vaccination requirements depend on the destination country. The Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) recommends that travelers check the requirements of their destination country; and
- · For OFWs and Seafarers: The issuance of the International Certificate of Vaccination for Prophylaxis for Yellow Fever Vaccine and other vaccination depends on the requirement of the agency/company.

7 IN 10 FILIPINOS EAGER TO TRAVEL ABROAD IN THE NEXT 12 MONTHS

Seven in 10 Filipinos are suiting up for leisurely overseas travel at least once in the next 12 months, a recent study by superapp Grab's advertising arm GrabAds showed.

GrabAds' SEA Travel Insights 2023 report gathered nearly 2,000 Filipino respondents, 82% of whom plan to make more than two trips abroad.

GrabAds also noted some of Filipinos' key habits, values, and behaviors when it comes to traveling abroad.

The study said 66% of the respondents prefer traveling with their families and relatives, while 47% of the respondents plan to travel with their spouses. A mere 38% preferred to go overseas with their close friends.

The study also showed that 59% of the respondents said that they planned at least one to three months ahead of time for overseas trips with travel times of three hours or less. Typical planning involves outlining an itinerary,

searching for accommodations, applying for visas, and preparing for other travel needs. Budgets are also among Filipinos' priorities for planning international trips.



NAIA REPORTS RECORD-BREAKING PASSENGER VOLUME IN FIRST THREE

QUARTERS OF 2023



From January through September of this year, the Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA) recorded 33,757,646 domestic and international travelers, а 30.943.105 increase over passengers registered during the same period in 2022. This statistic represents a remarkable increase in passenger volume for the same period in 2022 and is equivalent to 95% of performance for the first three quarters of 2019, the final full year before the COVID-19 pandemic.

"With this consistent growth, MIAA remains on track to achieve our year-end projections of 45 million passengers 275,000 flights by the end of 2023. These projected flight estimates are poised to surpass the pre-pandemic levels of 2019, reflecting the resilience and recovery of the aviation industry in the Philippines," MIAA Officer-in-Charge Bryan Co remarked.

The NAIA's flight on-time performance (OTP) has greatly increased along with this ongoing upward trend. The MIAA average OTP for September 2023 was 80%, matching the highest average OTP rate for this year, which was recorded in March. The improvement can be attributed to strategic use of technology and/or close collaboration with airlines and other stakeholders.



PH SURPASSES 4-MILLION MARK IN FOREIGN ARRIVALS

The Philippines has received more than four million foreign visitors since the beginning of 2023, Tourism Secretary Christina Frasco shared the inspiring data Friday.

The country hit a total of 4,005,465 in arrivals, accounting for over PHP316 billion in tourism spending as of posting.



"I am very pleased to deliver the good news that today we have managed to reach the four-million mark in international arrivals in the Philippines," she said during the opening of the 2023 Travel Sale Expo at SM Megamall in Mandaluyong City.

Banking on revenge travel and the expected influx of tourists during the holiday season, Frasco is optimistic the country could still reach its targeted 4.8 million arrivals by the end of the year.

"The Philippines continues to be a top-of-mind destination all over the world. We have a number of award-winning destinations. We're optimistic that we will be able to meet if not exceed the target set for the end of the year," she said.

DOT INAUGURATES CENTRALIZED TOURIST ASSISTANCE CALL CENTER



Tourism Secretary Christina Garcia Frasco personally inaugurated the first-ever centralized and multi-platform Tourist Assistance Call Center (TACC) on Monday, October 2, at the Department of Tourism (DOT) Central Office in Makati City.

The latest advancement in the tourism sector aligns with the focus of the Marcos administration to rejuvenate the tourism industry, seeing it as a catalyst for economic expansion.

It will also contribute to achieving one of the goals outlined in the National Tourism Development Plan (NTDP) for the years 2023 to 2028, which aims to elevate the overall experience of tourists visiting the Philippines.

TACC, according to Frasco, will function as a hotline and one-stop shop for local and foreign travelers, providing tourism-and travel-related information and extending support if any unfortunate situations occur during the tourist visit.


