

# TRAVEL PROTOCOLS BY MARKET



#### JAPAN

Travelers entering Japan from Guam will no longer be required to submit negative certificate (as of May 12, 2023).

#### SOUTH KOREA

All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to provide COVID-19 testing before departure (as of September 3, 2022) or upon arrival (as of October 1, 2022).

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

 All travelers entering South Korea are no longer required to register their travel information on KDCA's Q-Code website: cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal.

#### TAIWAN

There are no more COVID-19 restrictions to enter into Taiwan (national and non-nationals).

#### PHILIPPINES

On July 22, 2023, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. lifted the state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines.

According to Proclamation No. 297, "All prior orders, memoranda, and issuances that are effective only during the State of Public Health Emergency shall be deemed withdrawn, revoked or canceled and shall no longer be in effect."

As of July 7, presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 are <u>no longer required for international arrivals into the Philippines.</u>



# UNITED AIRLINES, SPECIAL FARES TO GUAM FROM 47,000 YEN INCLUDING FUEL

United Airlines will offer special fares to Guam from September 21 to 27.

Standard economy fares for flights to/from Tokyo/Narita, Nagoya/Chubu, Osaka/Kansai, and Fukuoka will start at 47,000 yen round trip. Fares include fuel surcharge and taxes. The fare is non-refundable.

Departure period is from September 21 to December 25, and travel period is between two and seven days. A weekend surcharge of 3,000 yen is required for flights arriving in Japan on Mondays and Sundays, and a surcharge of 20,000 yen or 39,000 yen is required for flights arriving in Japan on certain busy days.



The manga on display was drawn by Hokusai Katsushika more than 200 years ago and vividly depicts the rich expressions on people's faces and the dynamic movements of their bodies.



#### Mighty Purple, a foodie spot to stop by when you visit Hagåtña

Mighty Purple, located in Hagåtña, pioneered the popularity of acai bowls in Guam. They recently expanded its menu to include more than just acai bowls, and its stylish interior has become a popular spot for photo shoots.

The interior is fashionably decorated in purple. The combination of greenery, which is rarely seen in other places, is also a nice touch.

Acai bowls are the main items on the menu - offering six different types of acai bowls alone with different toppings, all at the same price. There are three sizes available, but the smaller 12oz (\$8.00) or 16oz (\$10.00) is recommended for Japanese customers.

There are two types of bread: the taro bread shown in the photo and purple (taro) bagels. There are many different types of sandwiches with simple ingredients, such as peanut butter & banana, cream cheese & fruit, etc., but the price is from \$5, which is great in this day and age.

Mighty Purple is only a one minute walk from Plaza de España, a tourist spot in Hagåtña.







# CHUSEOK HOLIDAY TRAVELERS ARE UP 583% FROM LAST YEAR

This year's Chuseok holiday travelers are up 583% from last year's Chuseok. This year's Chuseok is a particularly long holiday due to temporary holidays and the National Foundation Day, which increases the demand for international travel.

Especially as the demand for travel to Japan is very high due to the prolonged weakness of the yen, airlines are increasing temporary flights to and from Japan. The long holiday season has also increased demand for long-haul routes to Europe and the Americas.

Korean Air will increase its temporary flights by a total of 100 flights on 14 routes, including Hawaii, Guam, and Bali, while the duty-free industry is also stepping up promotions to capitalize on the increase in international travelers.

#### 2.2 MILLION PASSPORT APPLICATIONS NEXT YEAR



An increase of 300,000 passport applications is expected next year, boosting its predicted total to about 2.2 million, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' (MOFA) Bureau of Consular Affairs said. In 2019, the nation's total amount of passports issued came to 1.74 million, it said, adding that once the COVID-19 pandemic began to ravage many countries, the figure had dwindled to 316,000 in 2020, further diminishing to 233,000 in 2021.

It is expected to reach 2.196 million next year, the bureau's proposed budget for 2024 showed, which included 1.63 million for passports with a 10-year validation period, 408,000 passports with a five-year validation period, and an expedited service for fast-track issues at 156,000. This would represent a rise of 303,500 for next year, as the bureau estimated a total of 1.892 million passports would be issued by the end of this year. The bureau's proposed budget for next year stands at NT\$2.629 billion (US\$82.34 million), which is an increase of NT\$351.2 million compared to this year.

Meanwhile, when reviewing the bureau's budget report, legislators said that the nation's 14-day stay for visitors without a visa had been offered to holders from Thailand, Brunei, and the Philippines for several years. However, these countries are still not offering reciprocal terms for Taiwanese citizens. In response, MOFA officials said it remains an important task for the nation's overseas consular offices in seeking the host country to grant for visa-free visits, electronic visa applications, or improved terms for Taiwanese citizens.

"Our government has made an official request to Thailand to grant our citizens visa-free visits for tourism, which is currently under deliberation by the Thai government," a MOFA spokesperson said, adding that ongoing efforts are still underway with the Brunei government, for tourism visa waivers. It said it has earlier initiated a visa-free program with the Philippines, which should result in boosting their visiting trips to Taiwan. However, our side continues to negotiate with them on this issue, it said.

#### OVER 70% OF TAIWANESE PLAN TO TRAVEL ABROAD OVER NEXT 2 YEARS: SURVEY

A recent survey showed that more than 70 percent of Taiwanese plan to travel abroad over the next two years, with the figure highest for those in the 30-39 age group. According to the latest survey released by marketing consulting firm Eastern Online Co., in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, around 50 percent of Taiwanese respondents plan to travel abroad within the next year, and more than 70 percent over the next two years. Meanwhile, the survey indicates that compared to the same period in 2022, more than 20 percent of consumers plan to travel around Taiwan over the next week, even though the summer vacation period has ended, with around 21 percent considering a domestic trip soon.

In terms of age, the survey showed those in the 40-49 age group, who have greater flexibility in work time and more disposable income, are the most willing to travel domestically, while those aged 30-39 are the most eager to travel abroad. People aged 20-29 years old are less willing to travel abroad because most have only recently started their careers and are more conservative about entertainment expenses, while people aged 50-59 have more interest in traveling both domestically and abroad, indicating there is business potential in senior tourism, the survey stated.



As of August, the survey showed that "domestic travel" placed third among a list of purchases Taiwanese consumers plan to make, behind "dining with family" and "dining and drinking with friends."

In response to the results, Wen Shih-yin (溫詩吟), head of marketing at Eastern Online Co., said that traveling in Taiwan is more convenient and safer for local consumers because they can make travel plans more easily and spend less time on transportation, adding that business opportunities for local "short trips" could be further developed in the future. The results include a weekly and a monthly survey conducted by online questionnaire involving 500 and 1,000 people aged 20-59, from June 2021 to September 2023.

# TAIWAN MARKET INTELLIGENCE



#### COMPETITORS

JAPAN: Japan saw an estimated 2,156,900 foreign visitors in August, which represents 85.6% of the level in the same month in 2019 before the coronavirus outbreak, government data showed Wednesday. A recovery trend continued, with the rate surpassing 80% for the first time, according to the Japan National Tourism Organization. Visitors from mainland China totaled 364,100 last month, or 36.4% of the prepandemic level in 2019, increasing by about 50,000 from July but marking a decline of 63.6% from August 2019. China, which lifted restrictions on Japan-bound group travel for its citizens on Aug. 10, ranked third in a list of arrival numbers from other countries and regions. The most arrivals came from South Korea at 569,100, up 84.3% from four years earlier, followed by Taiwan at 396,300, down 5.7%. (September 20)

KOREA: Despite its hostile border, South Korea has never struggled to lure in visitors, attracting a whopping 17 million tourists annually. It's easy to understand why. The country has something for quite literally everybody: whether you're part of the K-pop cult, a spicy street food fanatic, history geek, or simply an admirer of the traditional (and highly Instagrammable) hanok architecture. But, emerging on the skyline of Seoul is a new trend that has tourists flocking en masse: botox. Tapping into the country's own obsession with perfection and image, the cosmetic procedure has become ubiquitous in South Korea's capital, where clinics offer it at rock bottom prices. (September 16)

INDONESIA: Indonesia's Directorate General of Immigration (DGI) has issued sport, music and art visas for foreigners who participate in sport, concert and art activities, an official has said. Director General of Immigration Silmy Karim has said Indonesia is simplifying the visa requirements for foreign athletes and artists. In the future, official athlete teams, event organizers or international artist promoters will no longer need to submit labor permits, police record certificates (SKCK) or certificates of at least five years of work experience, he said. Foreign athletes and artists only have activities in Indonesia for a short time, so they have little effect on local workers in terms of competitiveness, Silmy said. (September 18)

THAILAND: Thailand's central bank is monitoring the weak baht, which is not entirely bad for the economy and could help the key export and tourism sectors, the prime minister said in remarks aired on Thursday (Sep 21), as the baht hit multi-month lows. Srettha Thavisin, speaking during a visit to the United States, said the government was not interfering in the central bank's duty. The Thai currency's depreciation was driven by capital outflows due to interest rate differentials, Srettha told reporters. The US Federal Reserve held interest rates steady and its hawkish stance on monetary policy strengthened the dollar. The baht traded at 36.16 per dollar at 6.15am GMT, after hitting a more than 10-month low of 36.32 on Wednesday. The unit has weakened by 4.4 per cent against the greenback so far this year. (September 21)

#### HEALTH PROTOCOL & MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS


- As of August 7, 2023, presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 are no longer required for international arrivals into the Philippines.
- For departing international travelers, vaccination requirements depend on the destination country.

Below are the following requirements for foreigners traveling to the Philippines:

#### Foreign nationals of non-visa required countries

- · Registration via etravel.gov.ph. This must be filled out within 72 hours from their arrival or travelers can comply upon arrival at the special lanes for eTravel registration.
- A ticket back to the port of origin or the next port of destination outside the Philippines scheduled within 30 from arrival. An Entry Exemption Document (EED) must be secured for those staying beyond 30 days.



#### **HEALTH PROTOCOL & MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS**

As of 7 August 2023, following the lifting of the state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines by virtue of Proclamation No. 297 series of 2023, the public is informed of the following protocols on vaccination certificates as conveyed by the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF):

- · For International Arrivals: Presentation of vaccination status and vaccination certificates for COVID-19 is not required. All arriving international travelers are accepted regardless of their vaccination status:
- · For Departing International Travelers: The vaccination requirements depend on the destination country. The Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) recommends that travelers check the requirements of their destination country; and
- · For OFWs and Seafarers: The issuance of the International Certificate of Vaccination for Prophylaxis for Yellow Fever Vaccine and other vaccination depends on the requirement of the agency/company.

# PHILIPPINES LOGS 1,164 COVID-19 CASES FROM SEP. 18-24, 2023



The Philippines registered 1,164 new coronavirus infections in the week from September 18 to 24. 2023. the latest Department of Health (DOH) weekly bulletin indicated. According to the DOH, the country's average daily case currently stands at 166, up 13% from the daily case average recorded from September 11 to

Of the new cases, 10 or 0.87% were tagged as severe and critical. The DOH data also showed there were 11 verified COVID-19-related deaths monitored in the country since last month. Of the figures, six occurred between September 11 to 24.

Meanwhile, the latest bulletin showed that 260 severe and critical cases were admitted in hospitals due to COVID as of September 24. This is 8.7% of the total COVID-19 admissions.

# PHILIPPINE AIRLINES RESUMES CARRIAGE OF U.S. VISA WAIVER



Philippine Airlines received confirmation from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection that they may accepting resume nonimmigrant visitors to the States United who are traveling under the US Visa Waiver Program.

Passengers with a valid visa waiver authorization under the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) may

resume flying to the United States with Philippine Airlines effective immediately. Eligible passengers may also immediately resume booking travel to the United States.

Passengers previously transferred to other airlines due to proactive measures have the option to keep their current itinerary. # DOT SEES TOURISM SECTOR EMPLOYING OVER 30M FILIPINOS BY 2028

The country's tourism sector is seen to employ over 30 million Filipinos by the end of 2028, the Department of Tourism (DOT) said Friday. Tourism Secretary Christina Frasco made the forecast during a panel discussion at the 10<sup>th</sup> edition of the Global Tourism Economy Forum (GTEF) in Macao.

"The Philippines envisions itself becoming the tourism powerhouse in Asia. A few years down the road, by 2028, we foresee that tourism would have been able to employ a total of over 34 million Filipinos in the country," she said.

Based on the latest DOT data, the tourism sector currently employs 5.35 million Filipinos or about 11.4 percent of the total employment in the country.

Frasco said she expects that the Marcos administration's "whole-of-nation approach towards tourism development" will allow the Philippines to occupy a primary position in Asia, especially with its diverse offerings on sun and beach, and dive tourism.

She also assured the public that the Philippines will continue to promote travel and develop tourism infrastructure from a "sustainability standpoint."






